

French Army Creeping Slowly Forward Toward Fort Malmaison

Over fifteen kilometers liberating over ten villages, the statement said. Our Infantry has captured the line of Krnievo, Stragovo, Dragojel and Polchoko. Our cavalry is operating north of these places.

FOOT-TO-FOOT FIGHTING Desperate German Resistance Is Being Broken Down by Constant Pressure

The Serbians have pushed across the Cerna, gaining a foothold on the left bank near Dunje, south of Prilip. French and Greeks have captured Prilip. In the Lake Doiran region the British and Greeks continue to progress and have defeated Bulgarian counter-attacks.

Under similar and even harder conditions the army of General Mangin is creeping forward toward Fort Malmaison.

Any one day's progress looks very small, but the total gain in the last fortnight in a sector the vital importance of which has been lately insisted upon by German writers like General von Harden, who think it more essential than the St. Gobain massif, is remarkable.

Berlin Admits Break in Siegfried Line
