

U. S. CASUALTIES ON 3 REPORTS TOTAL 840

Pershing Loses 182 Men Killed in Action; Marines, 14. Other Deaths Number 195—Sixty-three Men Listed as Missing—374 Wounded.

Washington, Oct. 11.—Casualties among the American expeditionary forces in France were increased by 840 by the reports issued today and last night by the War Department. The army report given out today contains 397 names, divided as follows: Killed in action, ninety-one; missing in action, thirty-three; wounded severely, 170; died from wounds, sixty-two; died from accident and other causes, four; died from disease, twenty-nine; wounded slightly, two; prisoners, six.
