Londra, 18 ottobre. Il corrispondente del "Daily Express" manda da Amsterdam che il cancelliere germanico, principe Massimiliano, oggi (venerdì) riferirà al Reichstag perché in nome del governo e dell'esercito tedesco siano accettati i termini del Presidente Wilson. "Tale informazione è corroborata da dirette notizie da Berlino."

Il corrispondente aggiunge che la Germania dovrà arrendersi alle condizioni di armistizio che saranno imposte dal generale "Foch". Tale resa sarebbe questione di giorni, forse di ore. In parecchie città della Germania continuano le rivolte e le dimostrazioni in favore della pace, per opera dei socialisti e degli operai.

Un altro dispaccio da Amsterdam annuncia che l'ammiraglio tedesco ha lanciato un messaggio radio-telegrafico invitando a tutti i sommergibili di ritornare immediatamente alle loro basi.

Roma, 18 ottobre. Circa le operazioni al fronte di battaglia, il ministro della Guerra, nel pomeriggio di ieri, ha pubblicato due comunicati dai quali si rileva quanto segue: "Lungo tutto il fronte la nostra artiglieria ha effettuato concentrazione di fuoco sulle linee nemiche, sull'area retrostante e sopra trasporti lungo il Piave."
