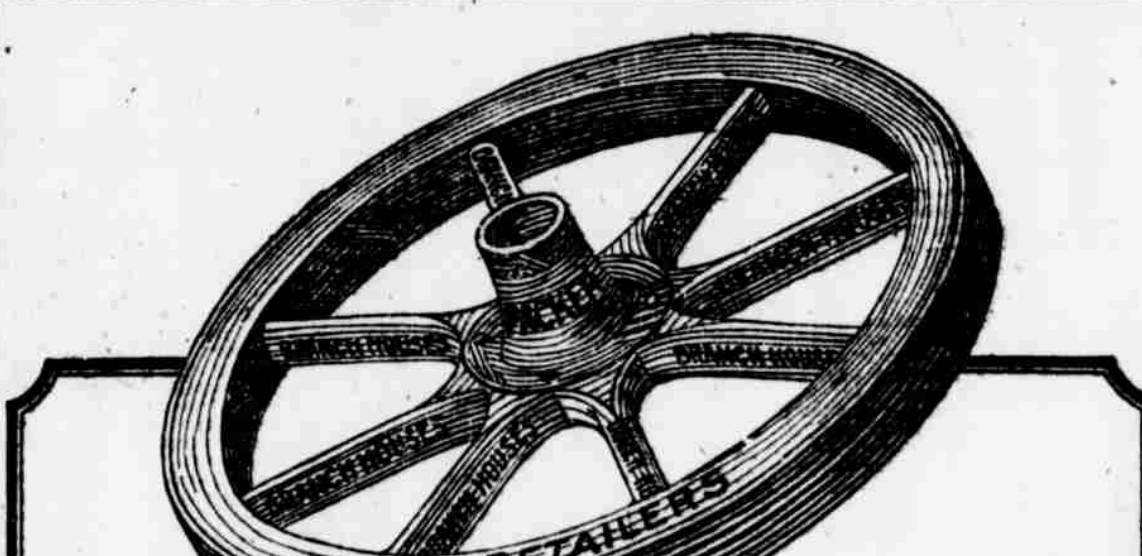
TESTS FOR SHIPBUILDERS
