Historic wrecks seen Retiring Germans failed to destroy big lock gate and electric works

I visited Zebrugghe yesterday, the scene of one of the most audacious exploits in the war's history. Along the coast from Blankenburgh the sand hills spreading the road from the beach were honeycombed with battery positions.

As Zebrugghe drew near the gun emplacements in many cases were obliterated by galling craters fifty feet across, made by aerial torpedoes or projectiles from the largest English naval cannon.

Sunken ships in harbor The tide was low and the wrecks of sunken ships stood high out of the water. Close against the mole and nearly at the end was the Brussels and beyond it unknown vessels.

Lock Gate Left Intact The captain told me that the Germans had left intact the big lock gate, whose destruction would have interfered with the working of the whole sluice system.
