1100 ALIENS AT MEADE ARE GIVEN CITIZENSHIP

Oath Administered to All by Annapolis Jurist—Wild West Show Sunday

Camp Meade, Annapolis, Md., Nov. 1. More than 1100 aliens in khaki took the oath of allegiance to the United States in the "O" hut of the Y. M. C. A. this morning. The men were selected for service from several States and while many of them had taken their first papers, a large number had never made any effort to become citizens of the land of their adoption. All are anxious, however, to fight for the cause of international democracy and following the exercises this morning all can now go to France as sons of Uncle Sam.

CRITICIZES PRICE FIXING

Cotton Manufacturers Protest Action of Government

Boston, Nov. 1.—The action of the Government in fixing the price of manufactured goods while refraining from establishing a price for raw cotton was cited as an example of "padding" by the National Cotton Manufacturers' Association in a statement issued here today.
