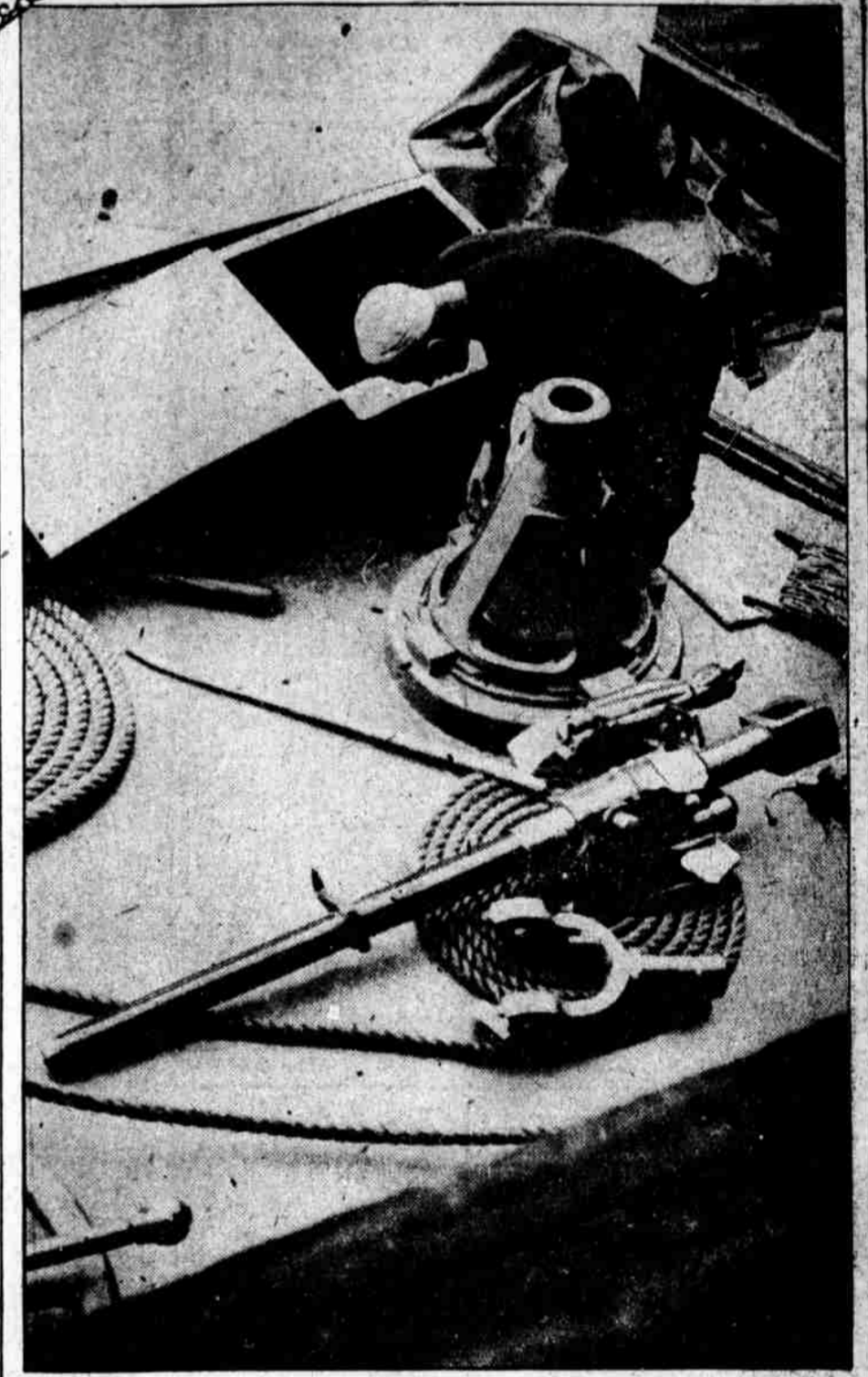
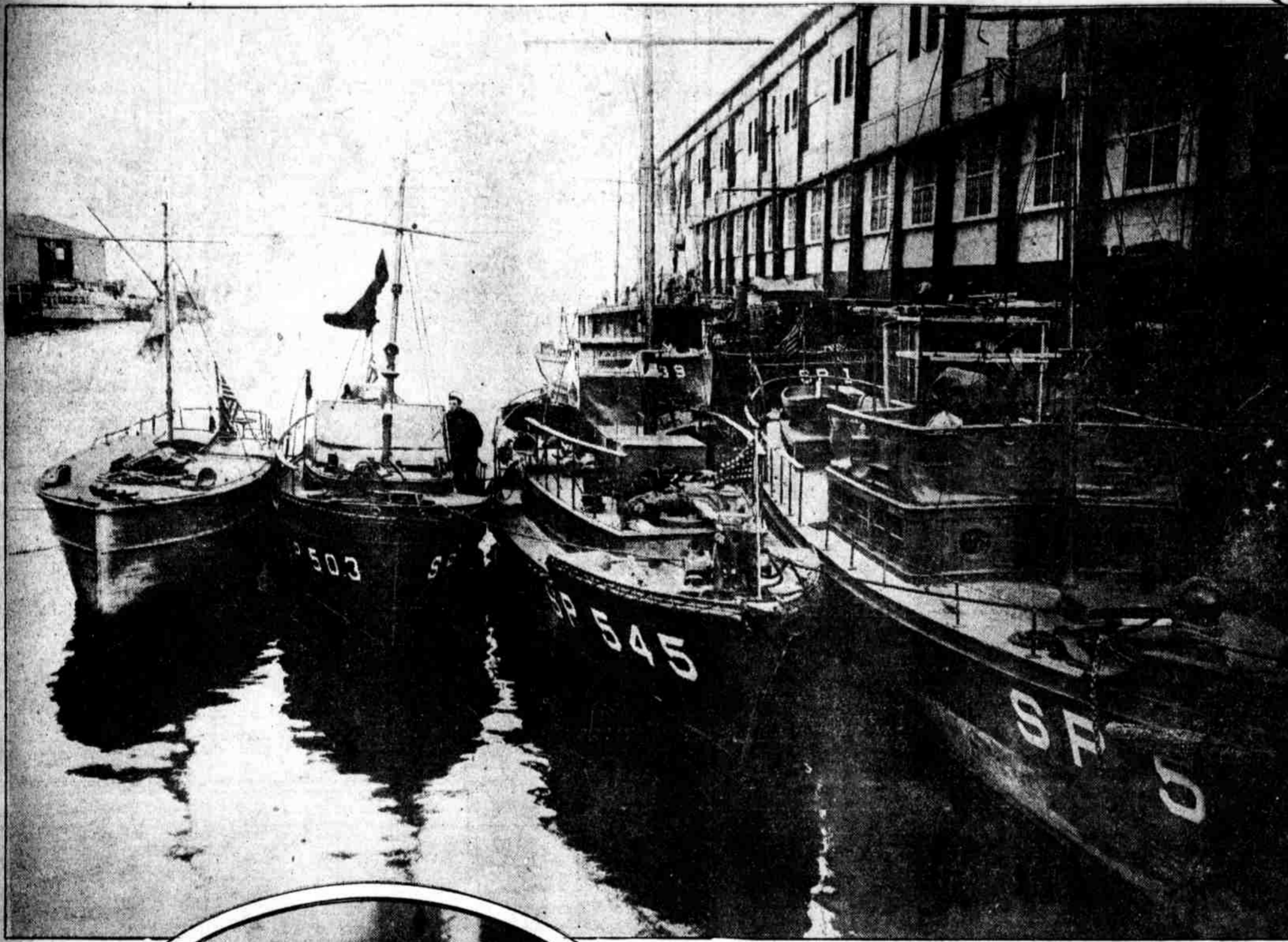


PHILADELPHIA YACHTS AND MOTOR BOATS THAT GUARDED COAST DURING WAR RETURN TO PEACE



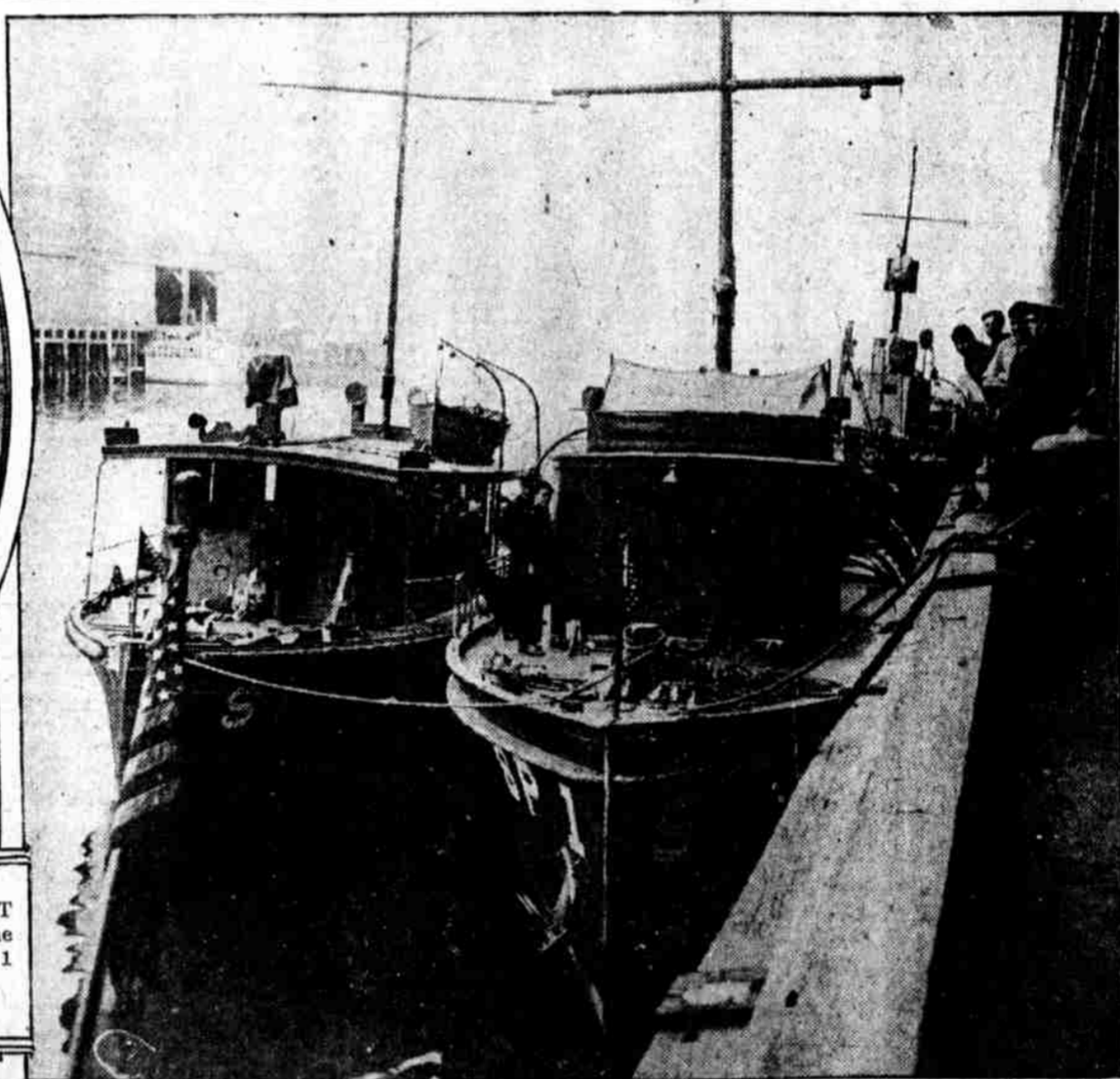

DISMOUNTING A GUN ON THE NIRWNA II

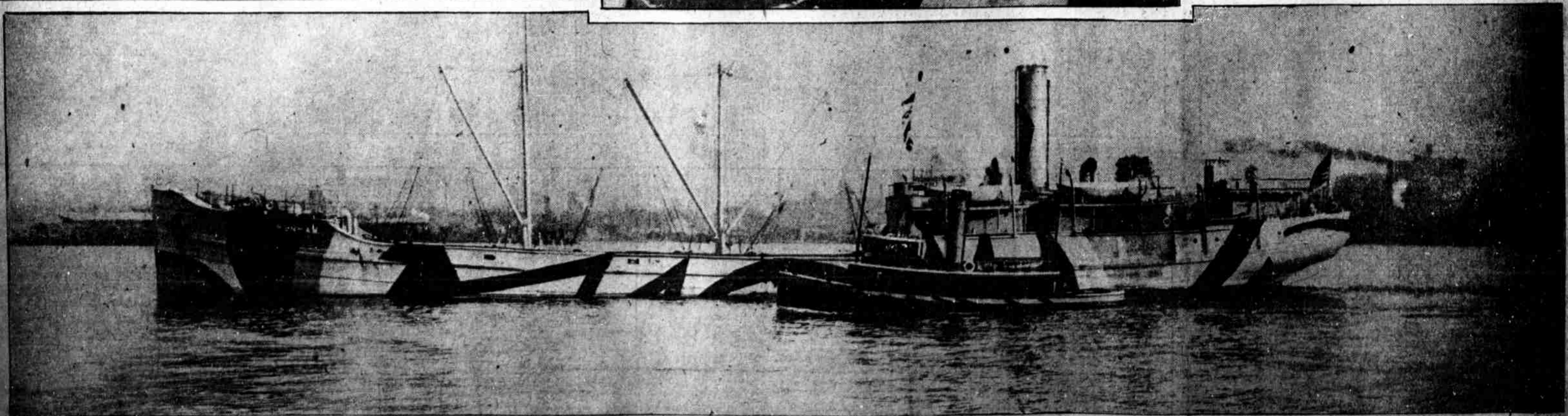


DISMANTLING A SUBMARINE CHASER'S GUN
