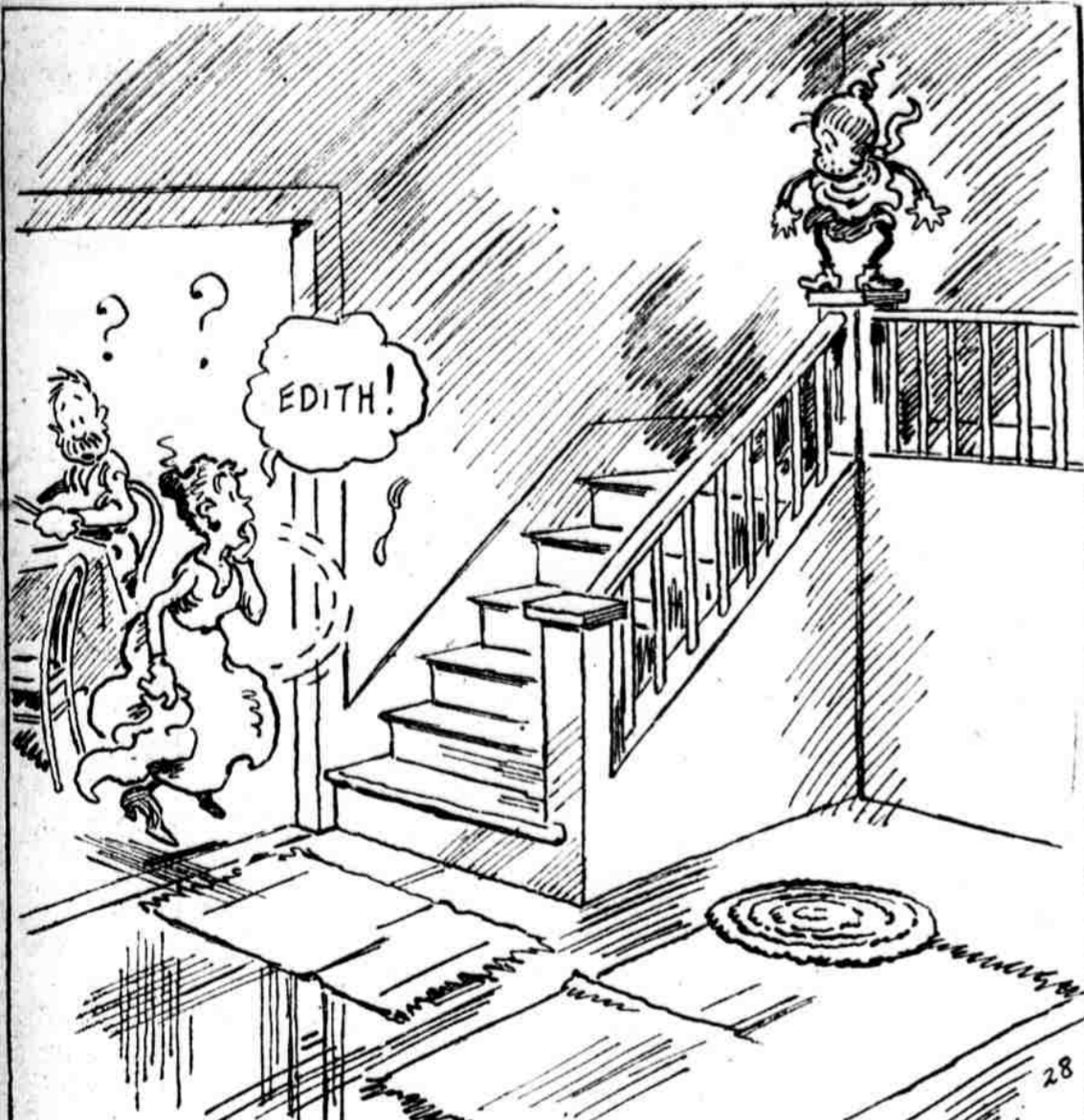

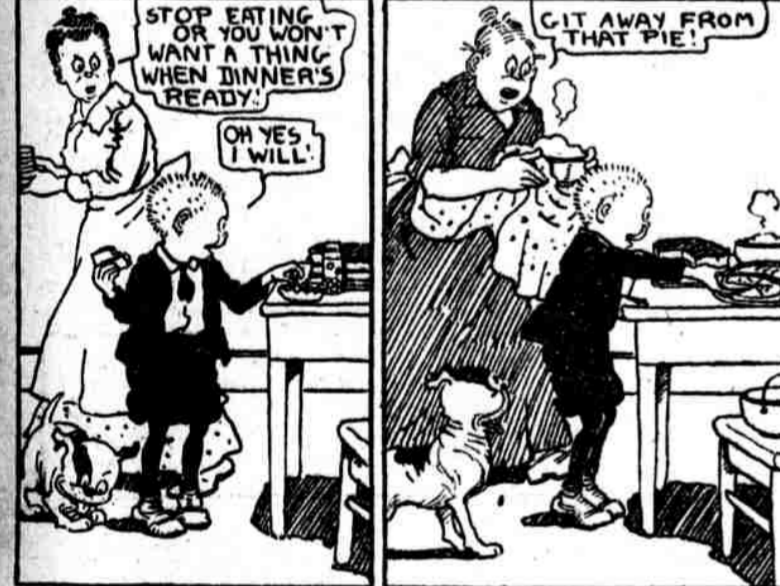

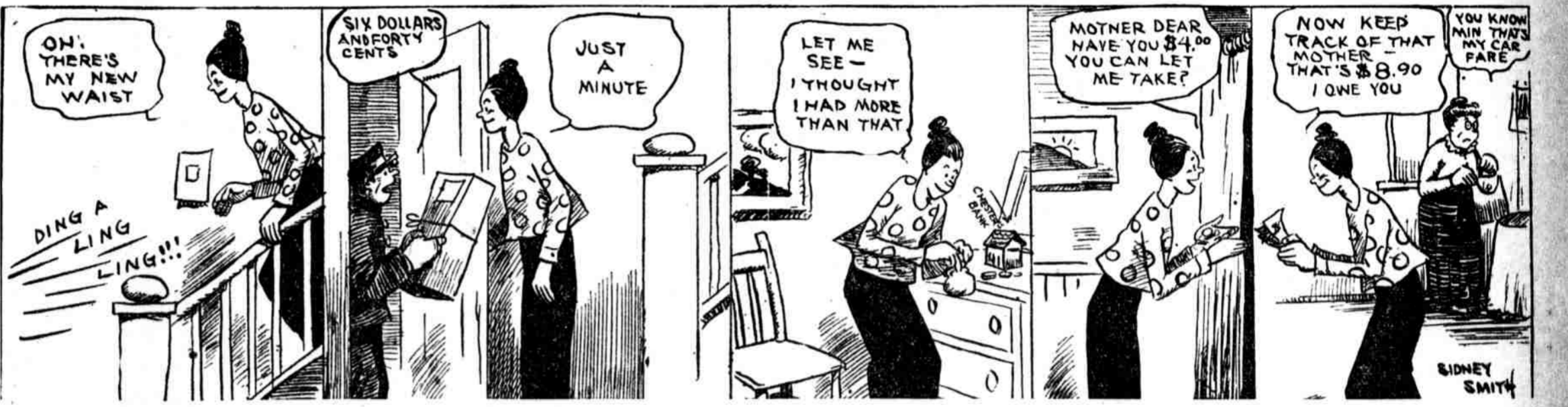
"RIEN NE VA PLUS!"
