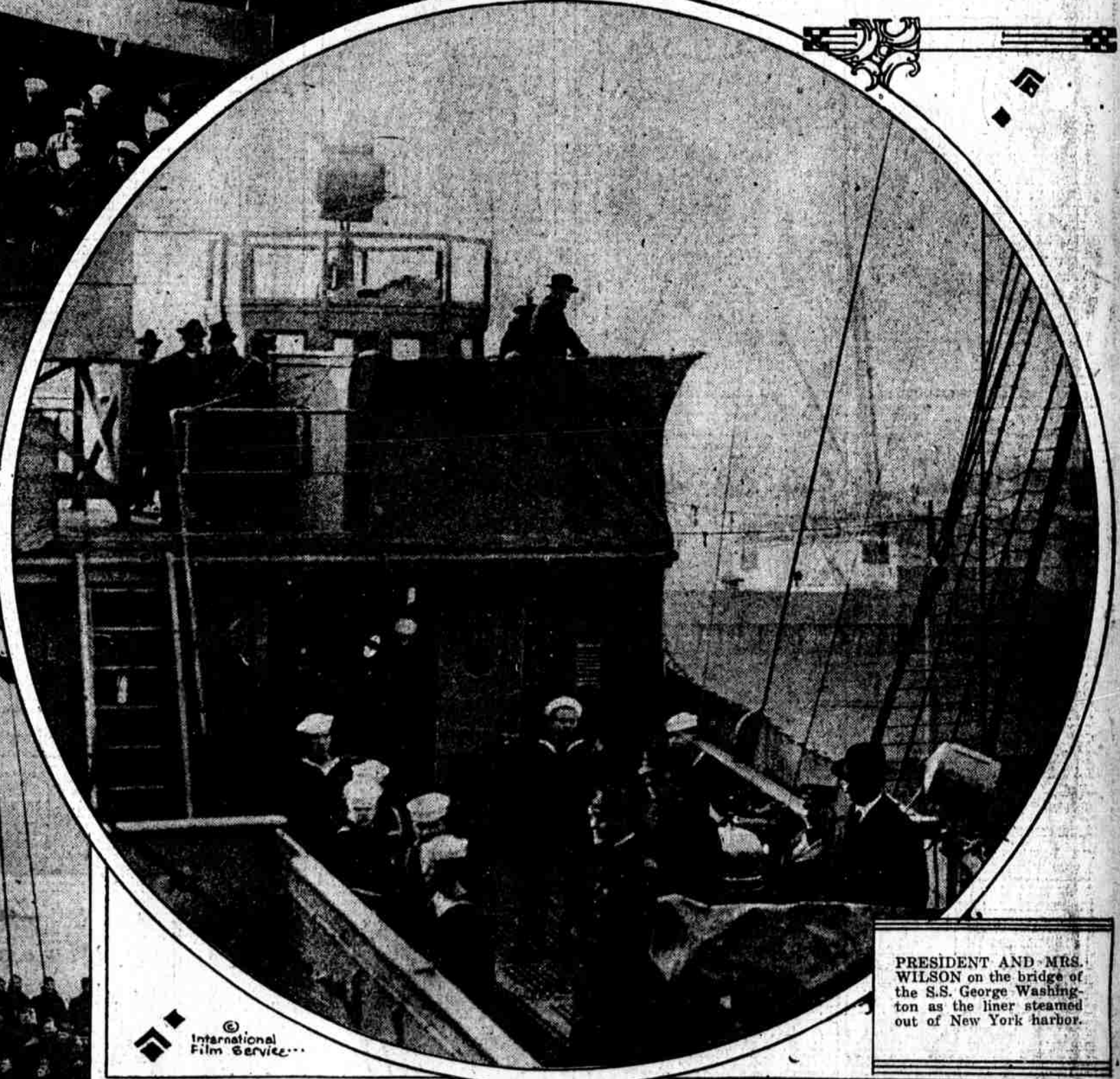


THE NATION'S CHIEF EXECUTIVE AND ENVOYS ON MISSION OF WORLD PEACE SAIL FOR FRANCE



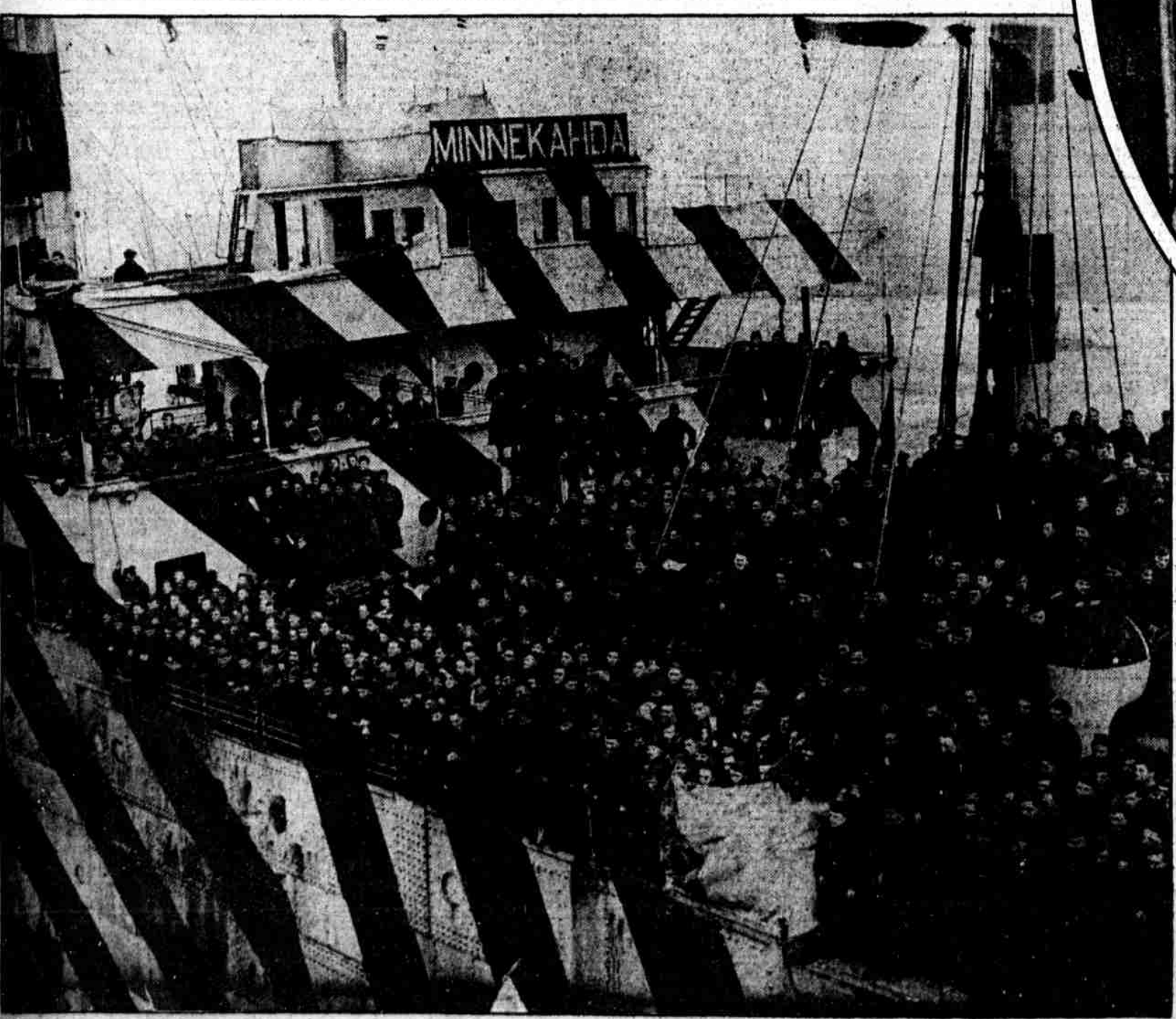
