

WOUNDING REPORT NOTES 21 DEAD Fifty-one Succumbed to Wounds, the Others to Disease and Accident NONE KILLED IN BATTLE

First of Heroes from Pennsylvania, New Jersey, Delaware, Maryland and Virginia Washington, Dec. 16. Two hundred and seventeen dead, 1026 wounded—these are the figures contained in General Pershing's casualty report for today. Of the dead, fifty-one succumbed to disease, two were victims of accident, none being recorded as being killed in action.

DIPLMATS TO MEND NEW RIPT IN MEXICO Washington Believes Negotiations Will Compose Matter of Tampico Shooting

Washington, Dec. 16. Diplomatic relations between the United States and Mexico, over a clash between the American steamship Montero's armed guard and Tampico authorities, are expected to straighten out this afternoon. The State Department officials hold that the Mexicans began the trouble, in which there were two Mexican fatalities and one American reported wounded.

The Mexican internal situation is, and has been, continually dubious, but the troubles there have been over-looked in the overshadowing developments of the world war. The government's turn of events in Mexico is a reported attempt to foment a revolution for the overthrow of the Carranza Government.

The United States will frown on any such movement in Mexico at the present time, in the opinion of officials and diplomats. President Wilson's mobile address against employment of force in government changes, would be the basis of Washington's absolute refusal to recognize any government set up by the anti-Carranza revolutionists.

It is known that Mexico's gold surplus is low, and it is regarded as doubtful whether the United States will grant an ultimate support and credits from the United States. There is good reason to believe that the United States will not support the anti-Carranza agitators.
