Total for Day 690, Including 516 Wounded—Grand Total 192,875

Washington, Dec. 21. The double list in General Pershing's casualty report for the day in eighty-five, of which twenty-six were due to wounds received in action, fifty-six to disease and three to other causes, eighty men are reported missing and 818 are suffering from severe wounds.
