187 in Day's Total of 318, Including 29 Who Died of Hurts

FIVE KILLED IN ACTION 119 Victims of Disease, 8 Suffer Accident Death, 9 Missing

Washington, Jan. 18.—General Pershing's casualty list today comprises a total of 318. Of these are the names of soldiers killed in action, twenty-nine died from wounds, eight are dead from accidents and other causes, 119 victims of disease, nine are reported killed in action and 148 wounded.
