Thirteen Others Died of Wounds, 26 of Disease, 6 of Accident

10 MISSING IN ACTION

Grand Total of Losses Up to Date by War Department 211,282

Washington, Jan. 21.—The casualties announced by the War Department this afternoon comprise 82 names. Of this total 27 were killed in action, thirteen died of wounds received in action, 26 succumbed to disease and six were killed as having died from accidents and other causes.

Continued from Page One many candidates as there were deputies to be elected. Electors were permitted to strike out a name or names on a ballot, but could not insert others to replace them.

The voting, under the German scheme, is based on proportional representation, so that each party elects representatives in proportion to the vote cast. The first round of the national assembly, the German advisers show, will be to draw up a new Constitution, defining the form of government and the method of electing a president of the republic. Another will be to ratify the treaty of peace.

Scheidemann Votes Thrown Out The Majority Socialists, who received the largest vote, had their party name printed at the bottom of the ballot, and in some of the Berlin large numbers of these ballots were declared illegal, and it is said that Philipp Scheidemann lost 11,000 votes in one ward alone.

Based on incomplete returns, the Majority Socialists had from 43 to 45 per cent of the total vote. With the Independent Socialists and the German Democratic Party, the Majority Socialists will constitute the Left of the National Assembly, with 65 per cent of the seats.

It is probable that Eichhorn, Spangenberg, recently chief of police, and Hugo Haase, one-time Secretary for Foreign Affairs in the Ebert cabinet, have been elected to the National Assembly.

The combined bourgeois parties in the kingdom of Wurtemberg and the province of Hohenzollern, Prussia, elected ten delegates to the National Assembly. The Majority Socialists secured seven, and the Independent Socialists none.

Allies Against Lifting Blockade to Let Germans Enter Commerce

Believed Action Would Help Stop Bolshevism and Also in Paying Indemnity

The view of the United States representatives was that the situation of economic strength under the encouragement of a lifted blockade, furthermore, the French are understood to have felt that it would be better not to favor Germany until the terms of peace were accepted by her government.

Urges Relaxed Blockade Some American economic experts advocate for enemy countries, at least Austria-Hungary, and possibly Germany, a further relaxation of the blockade to permit the importation of limited quantities of raw materials.

To Discuss League Soon The plans for the League of Nations are continuing to develop and it is deemed not improbable that the conference will get to its first full discussions of that subject by the end of this week.

The Italian Government has nominated Senator Scialoja, former Minister of Justice, as the Italian member of the international committee in Paris to study the question of the League of Nations.
