

FRANKFORD HIGH BOYS WOUNDED

Polish Nobleman's Son Went to Avenge Wrongs Done His Father

ENLISTED WHEN ONLY 15 Had Been Recommended for Commission — 73 Philadelphians on Today's List

Sergeant Anthony Grotthus, one of the youngest men in the army to be recommended for a commission, was reported wounded in action by the War Department today. He is the son of a Polish nobleman and enlisted at the age of fifteen, to avenge the wrongs done his father.

Grotthus's father is Count Anthony Grotthus, who fled from his estates in Poland several years ago for executive persecution for advocating the independence of his country. He has made his home at 771 East Allegheny avenue since he arrived in the United States in 1898.

According to recent letters to his father, Sergeant Grotthus has made an excellent record in the army. He is attached to Company L, Fifty-eighth Infantry. On September 29 he was severely wounded and gassed in the engagement in the Argonne forest. He recovered and returned to his unit, according to his latest letter. He was promoted to corporal while in training in this country and for his ability as a soldier was given a sergeant's rank after he arrived overseas.

Washington, Feb. 24—Four long army casualty rolls, with 3566 names, all males, were released by the War Department today.

The morning report led with 1803 names, while the afternoon list contains 1763, of whom 121 are dead, eleven missing and 1631 wounded.
