

2477 CASUALTIES BOOST U.S. LISTS Keystone State and Nearby Men Figure Largely in Today's Record

2413 SUFFER WOUNDS 13 Meet Death From Wounds and 20 Others Succumb to Disease

Washington, Feb. 26.—Army casualties released by the War Department today number 2477, all ranks. Of this total, 1202 were listed in the morning report and 1275 in the afternoon report.

Of the 2477 casualties, 2413 were wounded, 13 met death from wounds and 20 others succumbed to disease.
