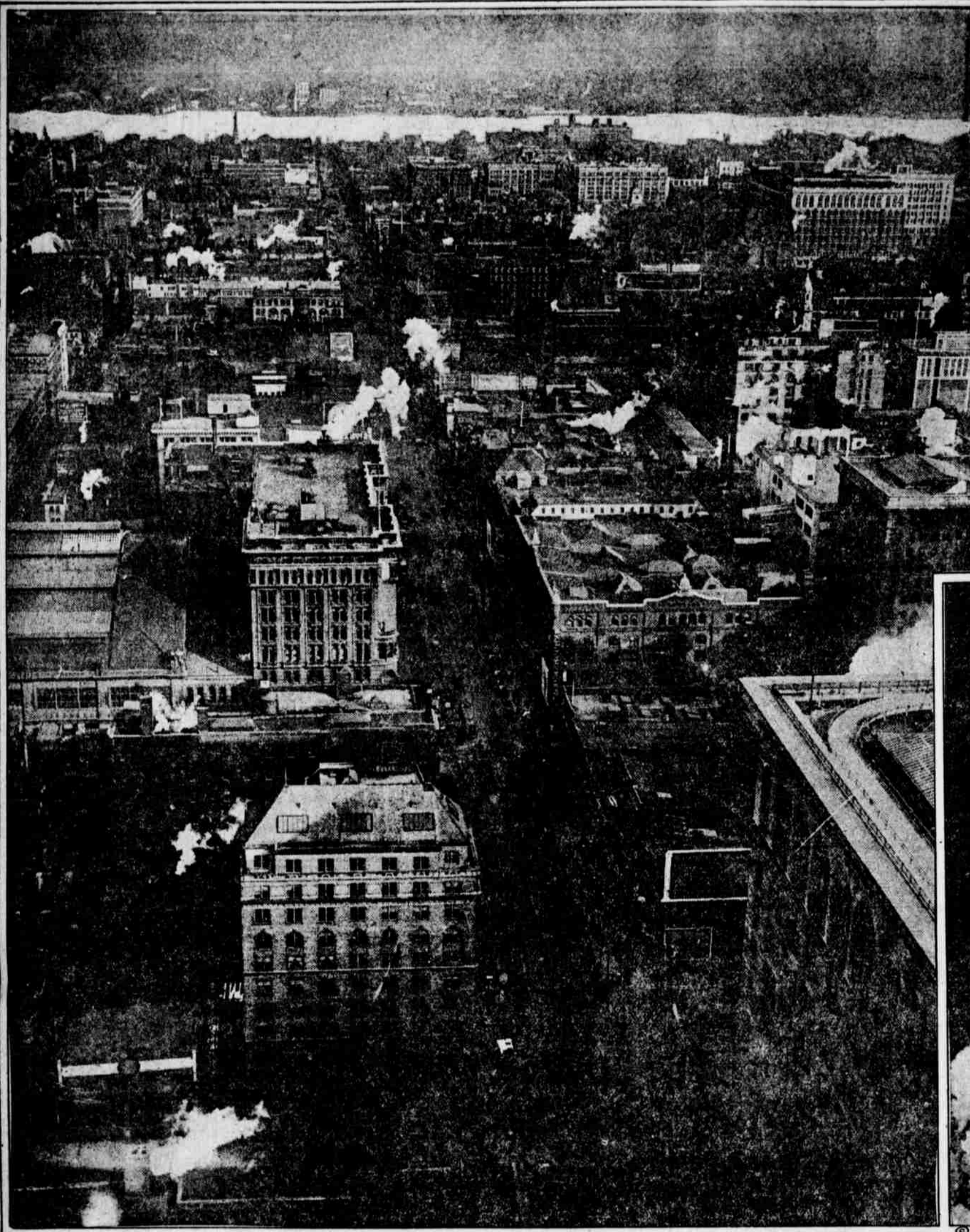
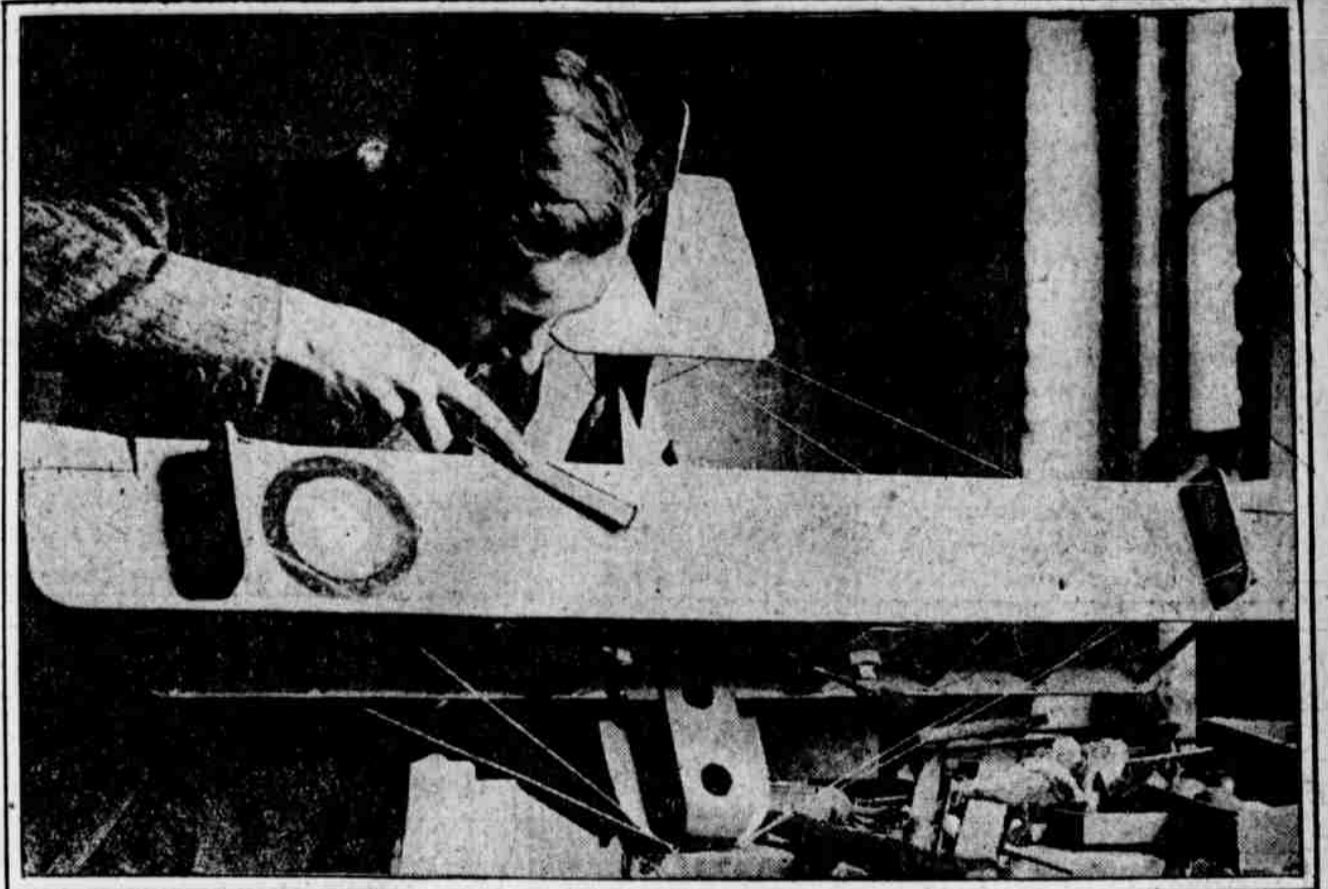


Market Street From Aloft and Chateau-Thierry Veterans Illumine Day's Picture Page

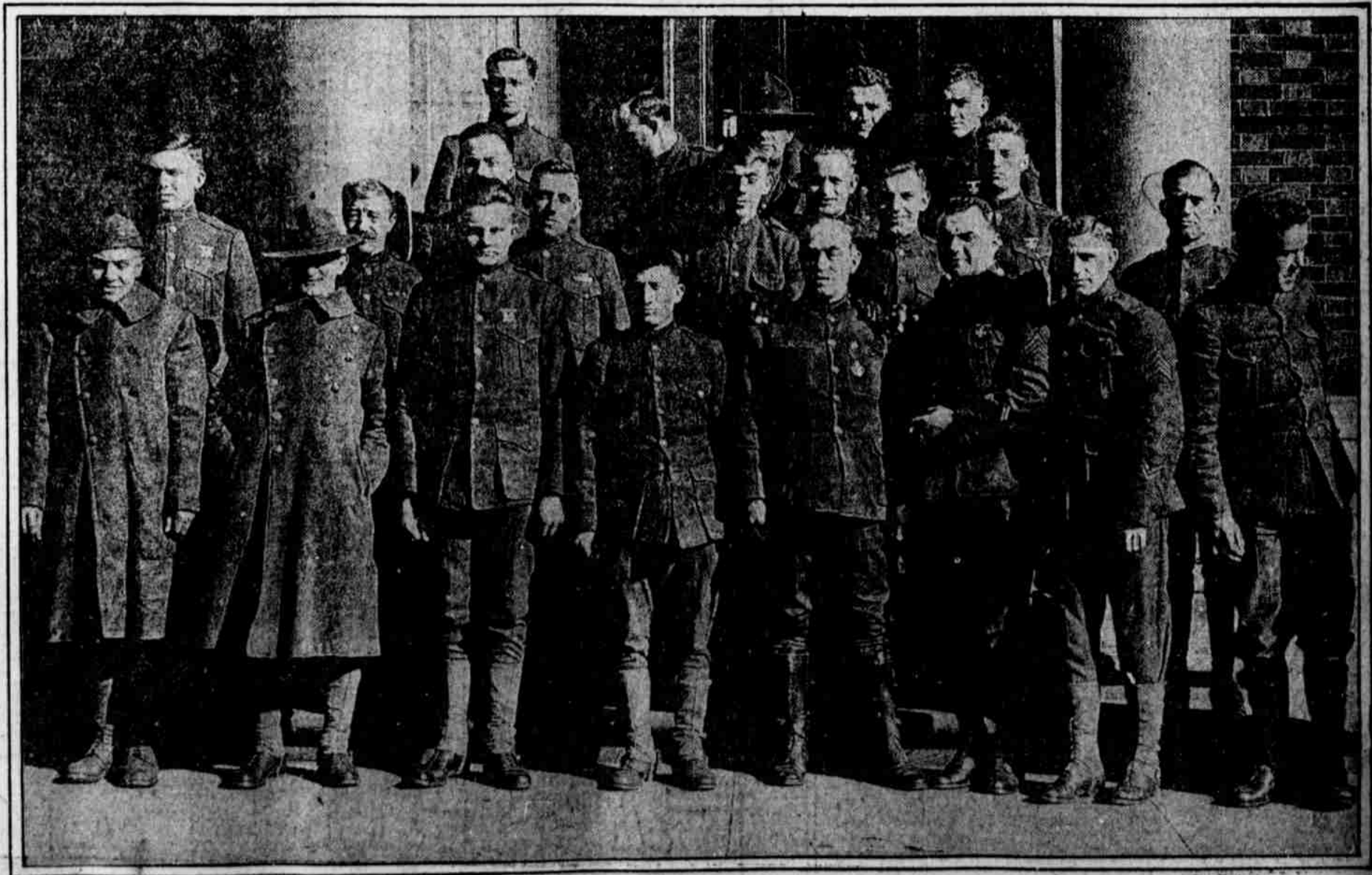
