GRAND TOTAL, 266,082

Washington, March 8.—Four army casualty rolls with three hundred and thirty-three names, and one marine corps list containing twenty-eight names, were released by the War Department today.

Of the total army casualties 266 were in the morning report, while there are 133 in the afternoon report, as follows: Died from wounds 102, died of disease 22, missing in action 117, killed in action 12, 31,745.
