

CASUALTY LIST HAS 280 NAMES

118 of the Number Recorded Dead, the Rest Wounded and Missing

SIX KILLED IN ACTION

Seven Dead of Wounds, 72 of Disease, 33 Accident Victims

Washington, March 18.—Four army casualty lists released by the War Department today contain 280 names, all ranks.

Of this total 123 were in the morning report and 157 in the afternoon report, as follows: Six killed in action, seven died from wounds, fifty-two died of disease, while ninety-two are listed as wounded.
