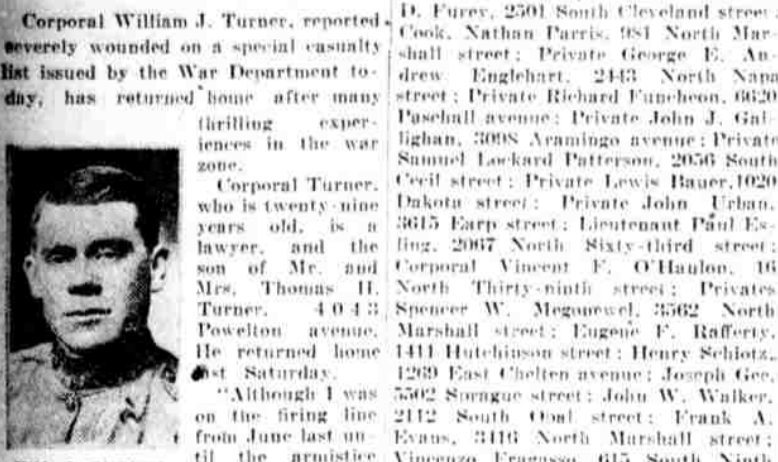

Yanks Killed by Treachery of Defeated Enemy, Says Corporal William Turner
WOUNDED ACCIDENTALLY



Corporal William J. Turner, reported severely wounded on a special casualty list issued by the War Department to his returned home after many thrilling experiences in the war zone.

Corporal Turner, who is twenty-nine years old, is a lawyer, and was wounded on the 25th day before Christmas, while his division was in the French Alps, near Laborange. He was accidentally shot through both thighs and the left hand by a civilian who was demonstrating a revolver.
