

CABLES AND WEATHER SEND COTTON LOWER

Market Later Steadied in Face of Selling to Relieve Concentrated Holdings

New York, May 5.—The decline of from 1 1/2 points in cotton prices at the opening today was in response to weak cables and favorable weather.

Week-end reports intimated that the demand for goods was in excess of the supply and that manufacturers could make a good profit even with 40-cent cotton.

This news encouraged outside buying at the decline, which subsequently steadied the market in face of Wall Street selling that was evidently designed to relieve concentrated holdings.

The market was only moderately active, but ruled steady to firm with prices working about 10 to 15 points higher on the active months. July deliveries, for instance, sold up to 20.80, or 37 points above the price reported on the reaction of Saturday morning.
