

WARNS OF BOLSHEVIK PROPAGANDA IN STATE

Sons of American Revolution Told Million Pieces of Literature Being Distributed

HONOR JUDGE BONNIWELL

When Trotsky found he couldn't run the New York home defense reserves, he took \$4000 in German gold and went to Russia, according to disclosures made last night by Louis Annin Ames, national president of the Sons of the American Revolution, at a dinner given to Judge Eugene C. Bonniwell at the Bellevue-Stratford.

"Trotsky served a year as sergeant of the home defense reserves in the Bronx," said Mr. Ames. "He tried to get a chance to rule the organization but failed. He wouldn't serve under the reign of law and justice in this country, so at the end of a year in service he went to Russia with a group of his East Siders to run a revolution. He was backed by German money on that trip."

Mr. Ames's knowledge of Trotsky was gained, he told the 550 diners, from following the revolutionists at speeches made at various places in New York city. He says that the New York police department was aware of the antecedents of Trotsky at the time the Russian was a member of the reserve.

Warnings that 1,000,000 pieces of Bolshevik propaganda were being distributed in Pennsylvania were given by Dr. Samuel B. McCormick, chancellor of the University of Pittsburgh, and former president of the state branch of the Sons of the American Revolution.

"It is our duty to see to it that we know all the good points of that propaganda, and to send all the bad features back again to Russia. Their propaganda is one of destruction of capital, liberty and civilization. It is our job to see to it that their program never comes to America. We have no room for bolshevism nor I. W. W. in this country."

Justice Daniel F. Cohalan, of New York; Royd Morrison, Henry J. Scott and Eugene V. Alessandrini spoke in praise of the work of Judge Bonniwell, who is now Pennsylvania president of the order. Judge Bonniwell was honored for judge of the Common Pleas Court to succeed the late Judge Carr.

"Ninety per cent of our reformers are content with fixing up legal techni-

calities and machinery instead of with the hearts and minds of the people," said Judge Bonniwell, in acknowledging the gift of a grandfather's clock. "Nostrums offered by men unfamiliar with underlying conditions are worthless. I would rather be a plain municipal

court judge with the consciousness that 307,000 untrammeled voters had supported me, despite trenchery, slanders and a flood of money, than to be governor," he said in referring to the last primary campaign of the Democratic party.
