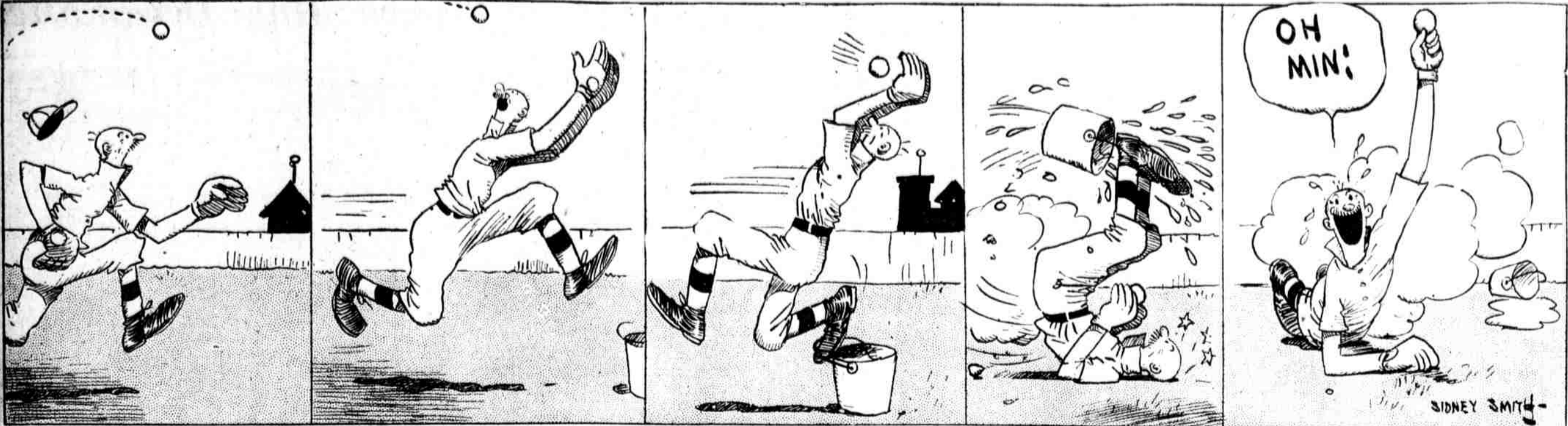

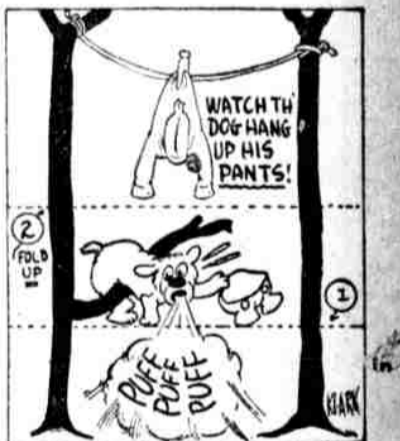

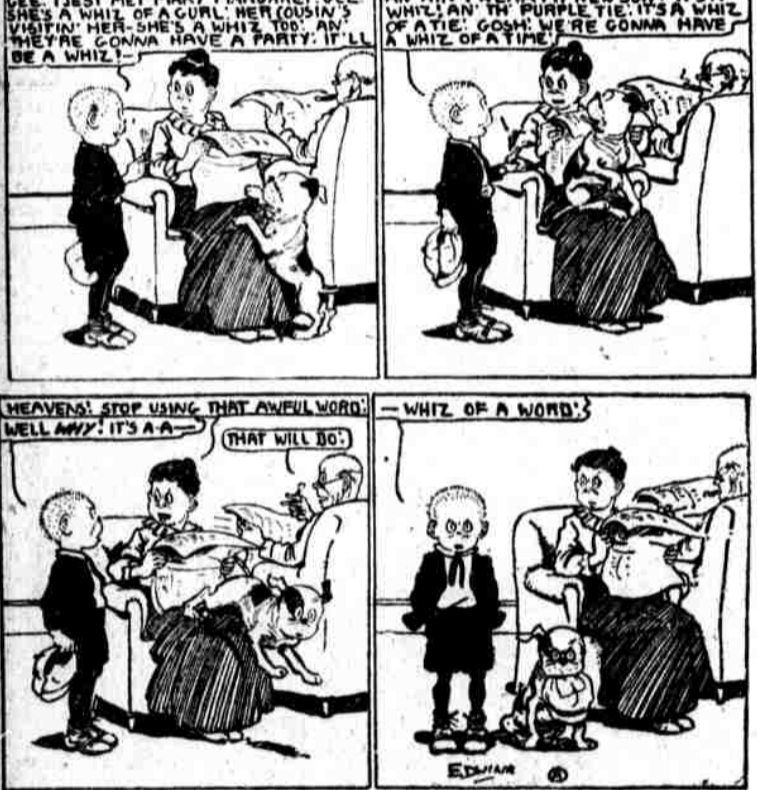
MOVING PICTURE FUNNIES
