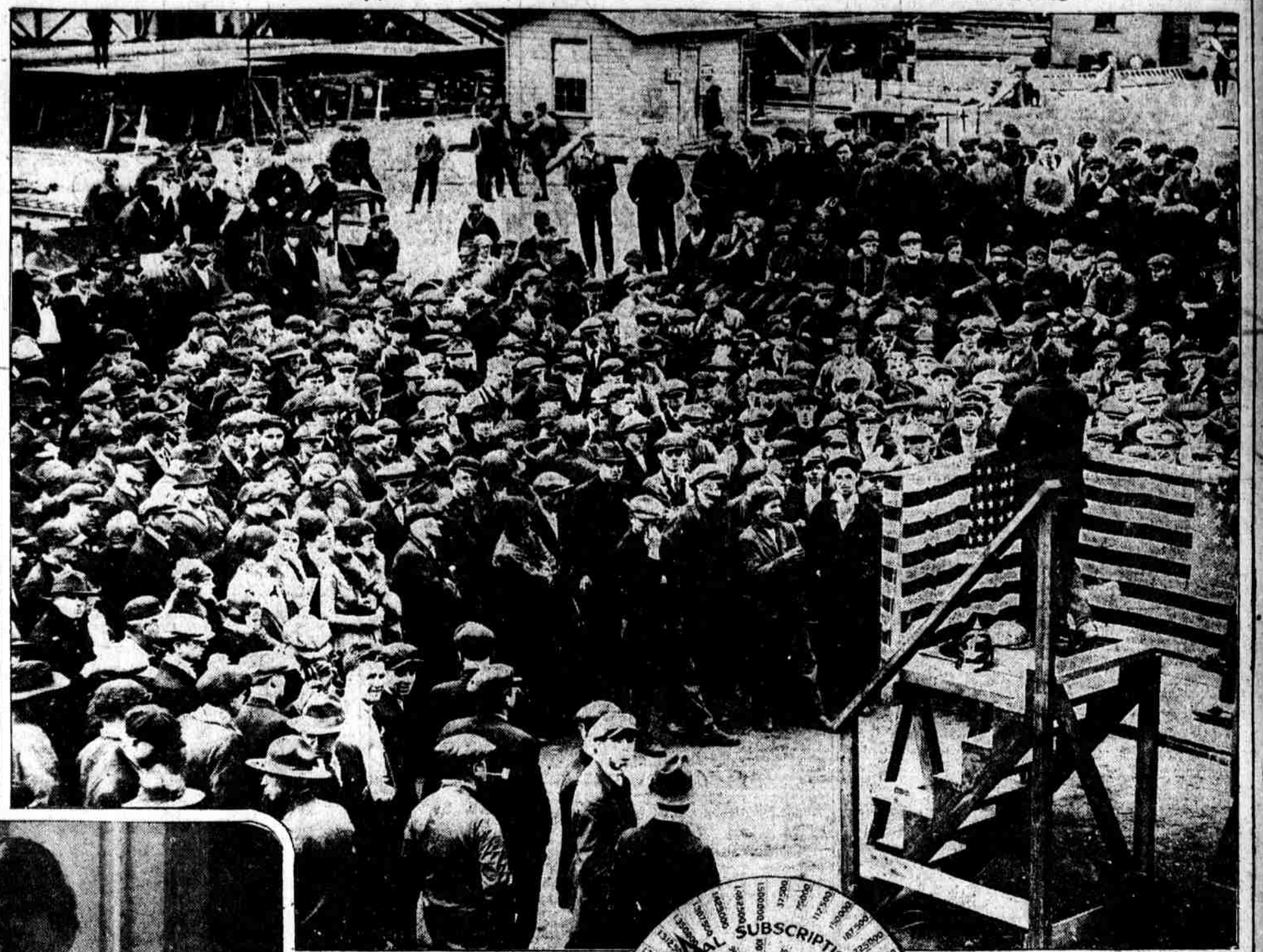

VICTORY LOAN APPEAL used in the Chicago Federal Reserve district. The photographic poster was noted by Dimple Marie Bowker.



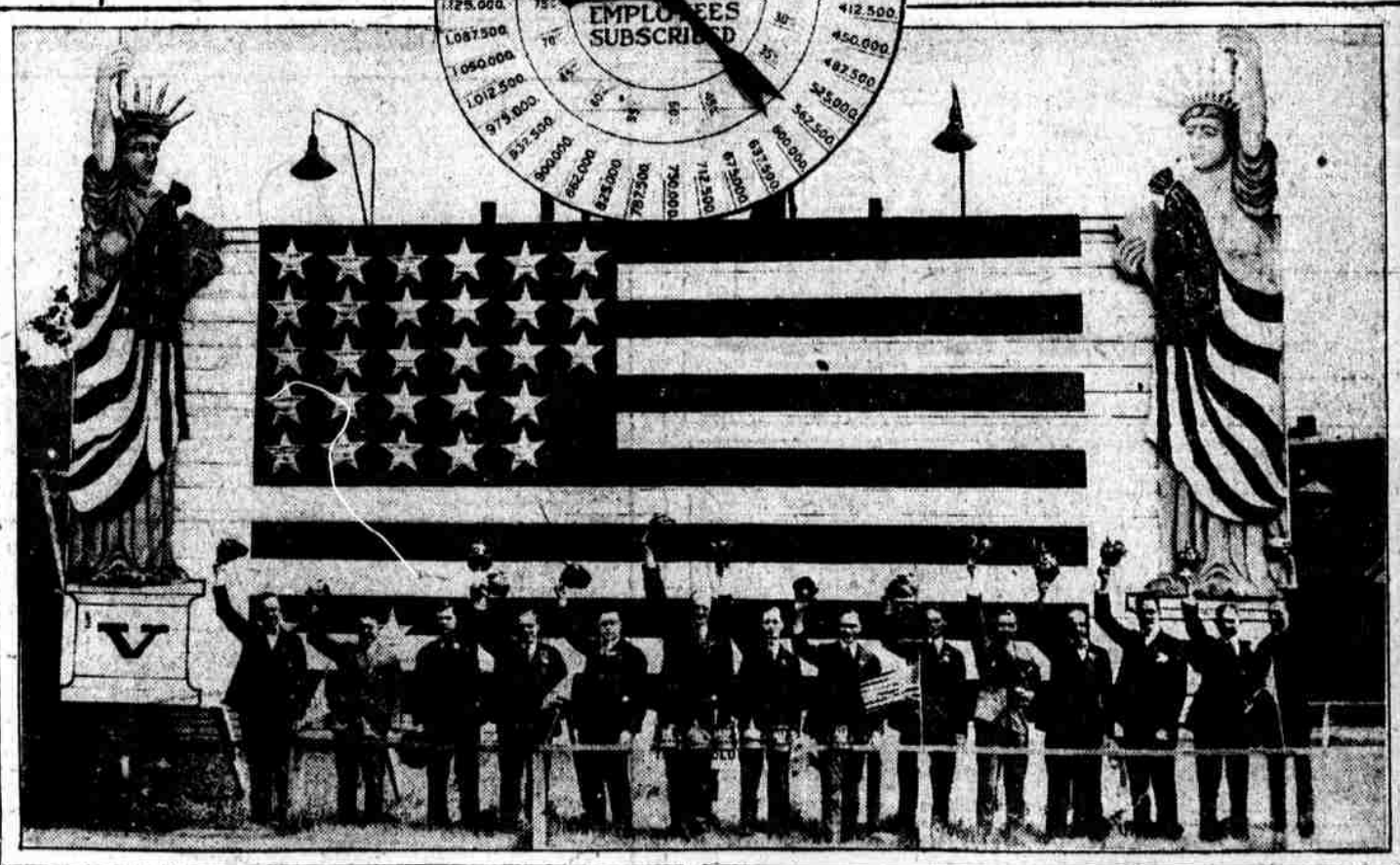
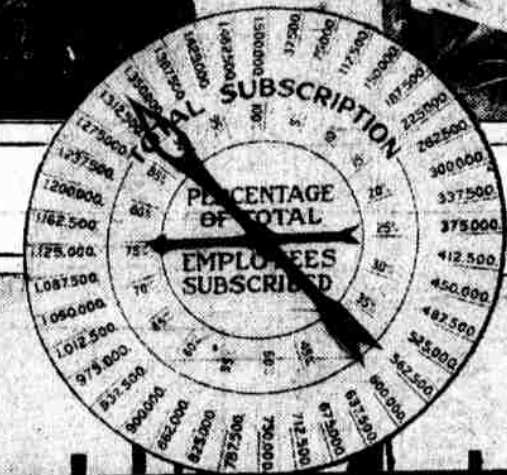
HELMETS FOR BONDS. Auctioning off boche hats to shipworkers at a Hog Island Loan rally.



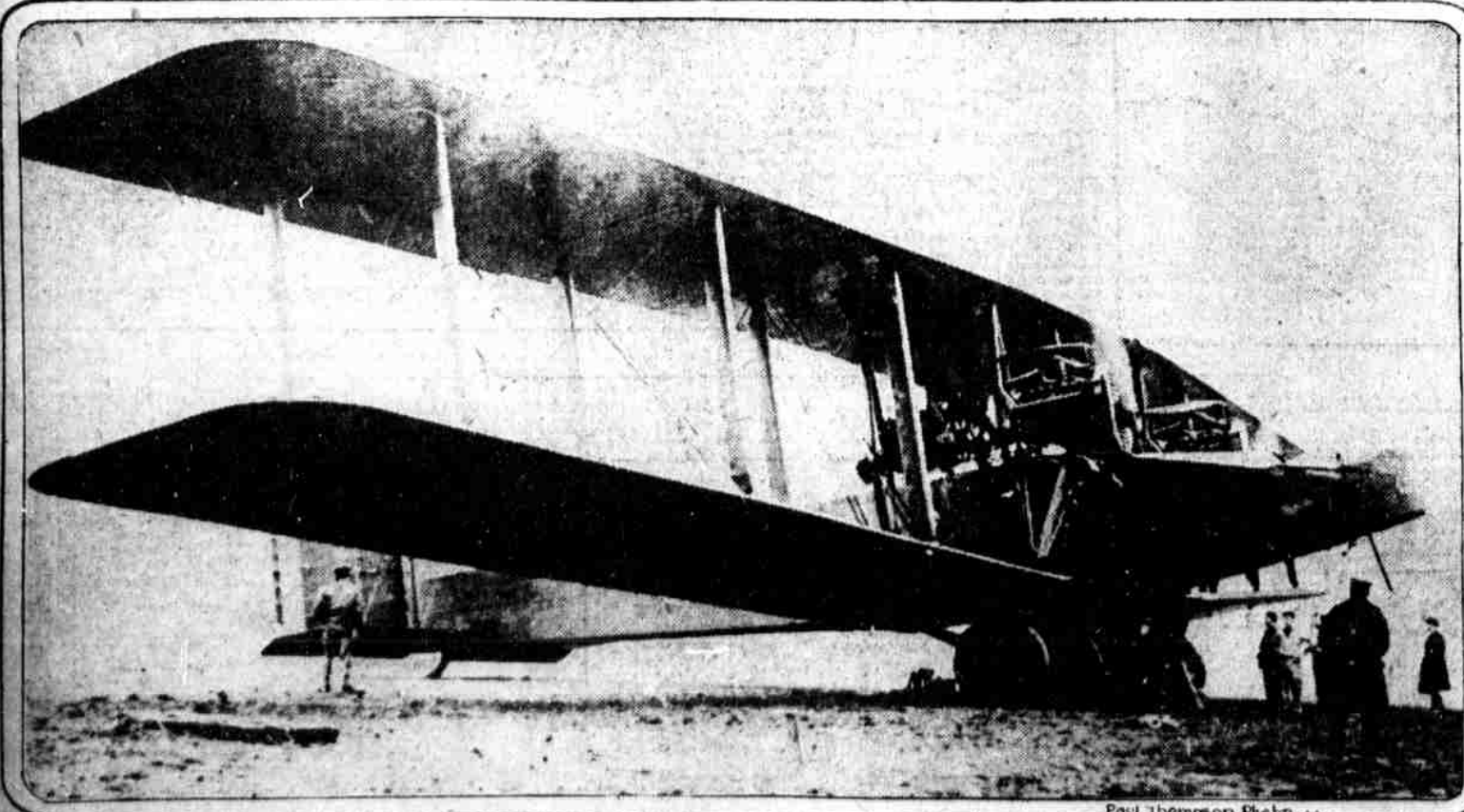
