

SEAPLANES EQUIPPED WITH SECRET DEVICE

Aero Congress Hears of New Method to Guide Fliers on Course in Fog

Atlantic City, May 9.—Success or failure for the United States navy in its hopes to outstrip Great Britain and all other friendly rivals in the initial transatlantic passage by air may depend upon the practicability of a new and carefully guarded device designed to enable fliers to hold their course in dense fogs or under adverse atmospheric conditions.

That the big seaplanes which the United States groomed at Rockaway to undertake the across-Atlantic hop have been equipped with this and other devices of which the world heretofore has been kept in ignorance was disclosed to the Pan-American Aero Congress yesterday by Eustace J. B. Brady, chairman of steam engineering, and Earl C. Hanson, of the radio division of the same bureau, by express permission of Franklin D. Roosevelt, assistant secretary of the navy.

The same device which calls for the use of audio frequency energy is to be employed also to enable fliers to locate landing stations at night and during heavy fogs, and also to fix their approximate altitude. Working out of the new system, it is claimed, will enable airmen also to follow the most direct line possible between cities.

Major Reed Landis, second American ace and son of Judge Keeseev Landis, narrowly escaped serious injury yesterday when a plane in which he was riding with Pilot Gardner, of the aerial mail service, plunged to the ground at the airport as it was being prepared for a flight to New York. Motor trouble developed just after the plane left the ground, and it tumbled like a crippled bird. Major Landis and Gardner disentangled themselves from the wreckage, while hundreds were rushing to their aid.
