

"The policy to be followed by our troops in any country is one to be determined by the executive.

"It was clearly announced in the most public and solemn manner that the United States did not contemplate any interference of any kind with the political sovereignty of Russia, any intervention in her internal affairs or any impairment of her territorial integrity.

"The United States does not intend to permit any of its agents to inter-fere with the sovereign rights of the Russian people. Our aim has been to carry out to the letter the policy of our government. 
