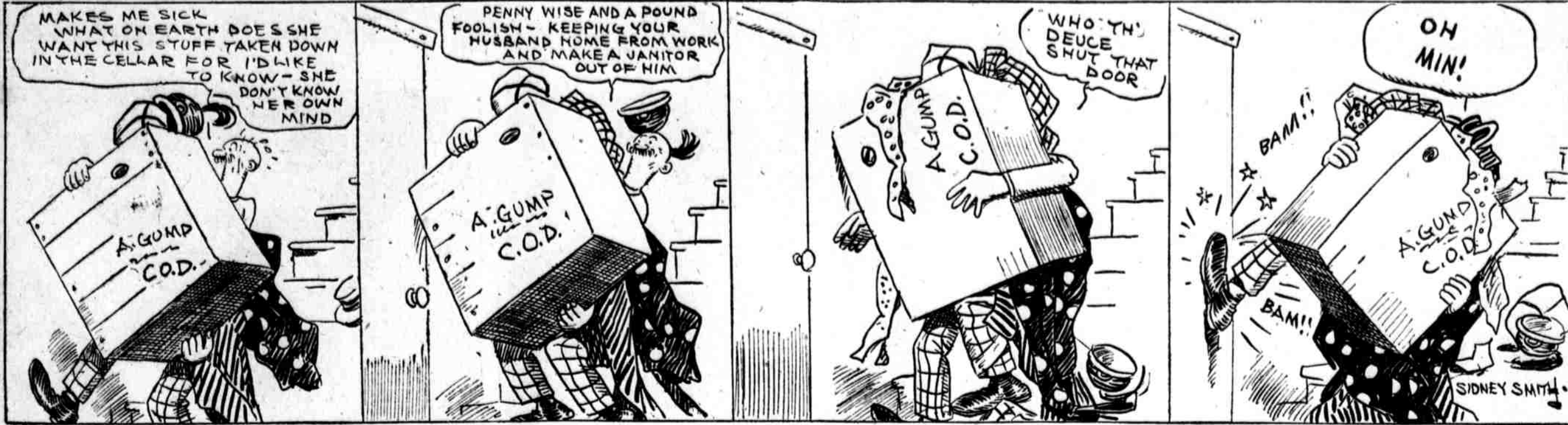

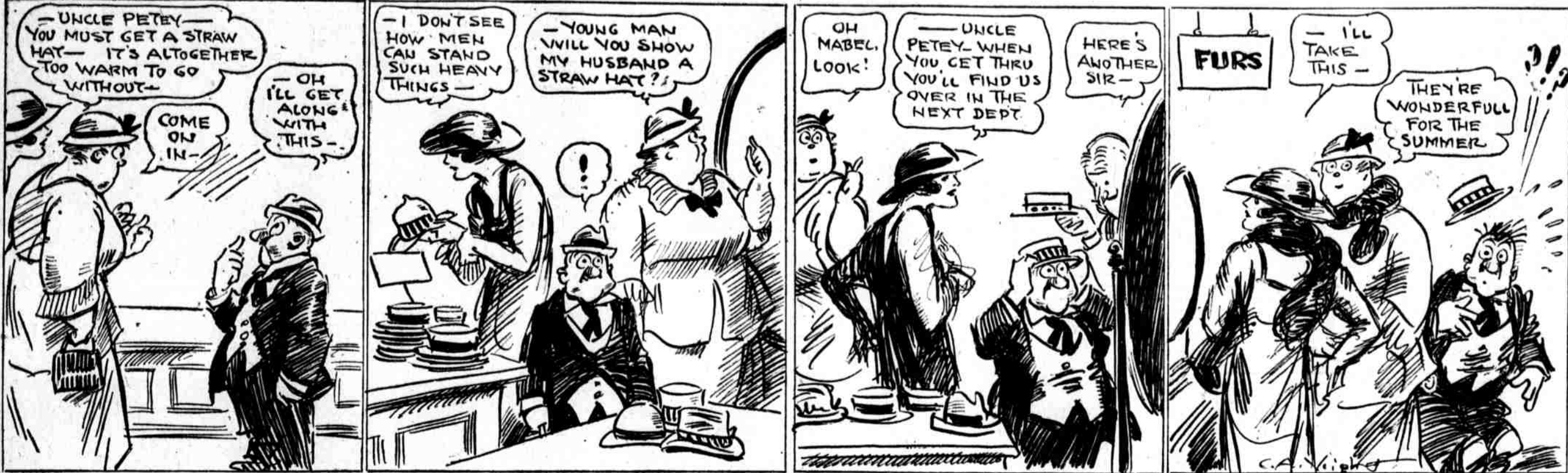
The Young Lady Across the Way

MOVING PICTURE FUNNIES



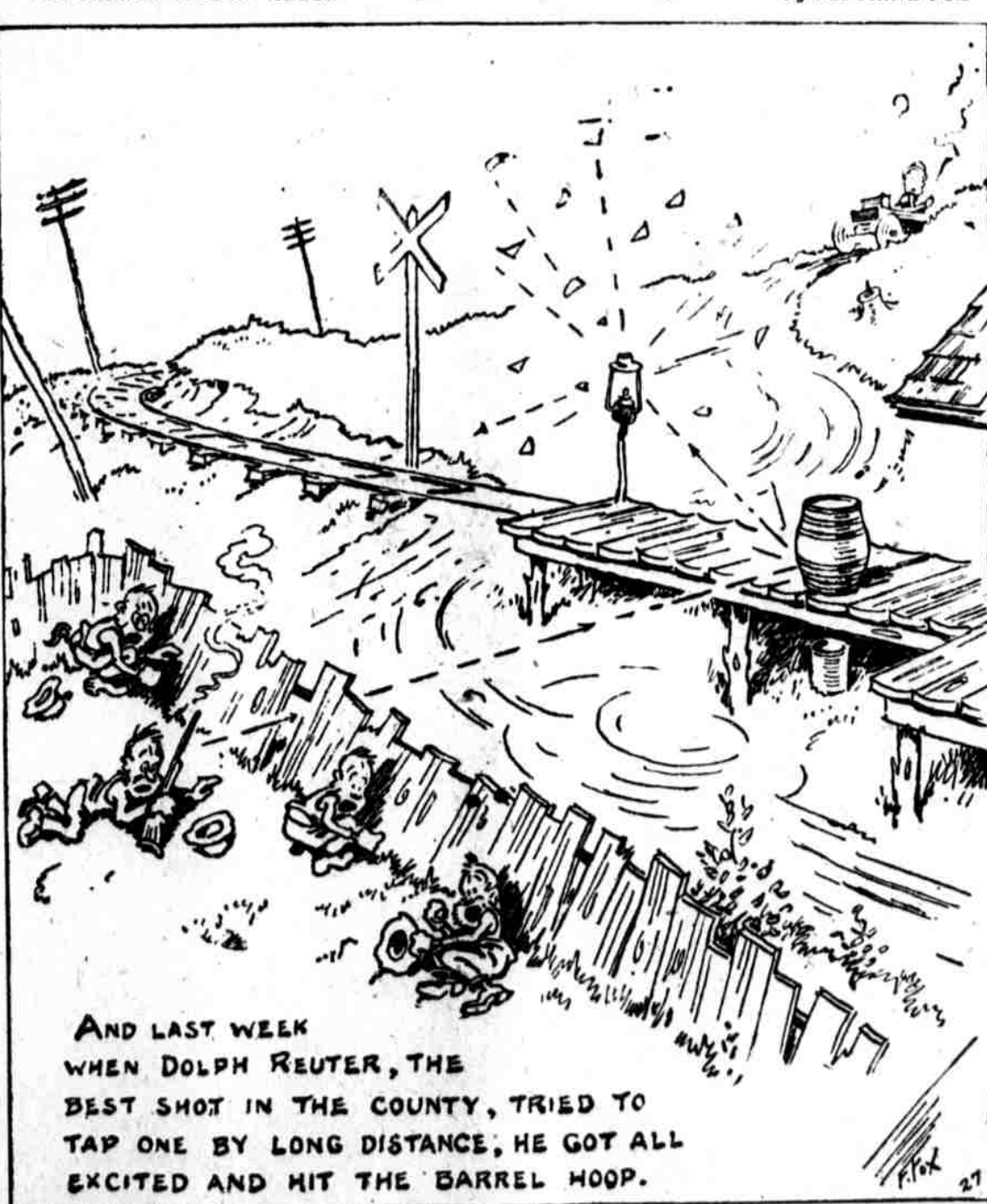
