

A Glance at Some of the Most Exquisite Dining-Room Suits to Be Found, Perhaps, in the World

Probably in no branch of industrial art has America made such a signal advance as in the production of fine furniture. A very striking illustration of this will be found in the collection of magnificent dining-room suits shown on the Sixth Floor. Lovers of fine cabinet work have pronounced some of these works of art, and no wonder, for in design, construction and ornamental detail and in their beautifully matched and figured wood they worthily uphold the purest standards left by the old master designers.

Relatively speaking, the prices of these suits are not high. For every dollar they cost they carry a full measure of beauty, stability and excellence, to say nothing of the feeling that might be called joy-of-possession.

For instance, we are showing for \$1325 a Queen Anne diningroom suit in which each drawer and cupboard door is built up of beautifully figured mahogany with heavy bordered panels. The trimmings are in the silver finish. The china closet has panel doors and a cupboard base. The serving table is after the old commode style and has two large and two small drawers. The table has a 54-inch top and the chairs have upholstered seats and backs. This suit can also be had in walnut at the same price.

Another excellent copy is one in William and Mary for \$665-built of figured walnut, the front panels being in burl walnut. The top edge of all of the pieces shows a shallow carving, and there are carved insignia on the cupboard woors. The lower center portion of the buffet drops, forming a shelf exposing three sliding trays.

Thomas Chippendale is represented in this collection by a suit for \$925. It is what some connoisseurs call "French Chippendale." All of the pieces show the convex base, the graceful cabriole leg both front and rear, finishing off with the mystic ball and the dragon's claw,

An Italian renaissance suit at \$1015 is at once massive and dignified, simple and fascinating. The table is oblong and the chairs have red plush seats and backs with silk fringe.

For \$692 there is a copy of Louis Quatorze in figured walnut. The chairs are in a rich figured tapestry, the backs are in a brown cane, The extension table is oblong with slightly curved ends. The panel door china closet, buffet and serving table have the stretcher in the base.

Another French suit is after Louis Quinze, the price being \$655. The panels and drawer fronts are of a beautiful navy burl mahogany, while the remainder is in the regular brown shade of mahogany. The chairs are in hair cloth and the extension table is oblong with slightly curved ends.
