

JOFFRE GETS PLACE

Will Head Troops in Victory Parade and Then Sit Beside Poincaré
Paris, July 11.—Marshal Joffre, it is announced, will lead the troops during the first part of the triumphal march here on Bastille Day, July 14, but on arriving at the presidential stand he will leave the procession and will be invited to take his seat beside M. Poincaré.

More than 100 deputies, dissatisfied with the place that had been given Marshal Joffre in the parade, introduced in the chamber a resolution inviting the government "to give Marshal Joffre and commanders of armies and army corps under him places in the victory parade merited by their eminent services in the battle of the Marne which saved the country and civilization."

The newspaper announced the government has not invited Marshal Joffre to participate in Monday's parade in the place which is due him. This news is false.
