

WOMEN'S 'Y' FIGHTS COMMERCIAL BODY

Mrs. King Finds Opposition to Forming Chamber of Commerce Here

FIELD FOR BOTH, SHE SAYS

Organization of business women into a women's chamber of commerce is being opposed by the national Y. W. C. A., according to Philadelphia women interested in the bringing together of members of their sex in a business club. "The Y. W. C. A.," said Mrs. Leola King, superintendent of the West Philadelphia Homeopathic Hospital, who is organizer for the women's chamber of commerce in this district, "is the only body that has opposed the organizing of the proposed chamber. Whether its executive board feels it would lose power and prestige if business women organized in a nonsectarian and nonpolitical body, I do not know. "For many years the Y. W. C. A. has been one of the biggest national organizations of women and I suppose in some manner the women's chamber of commerce might be its rival. But the men have found plenty of work and need for both a Y. M. C. A. and a men's chamber of commerce, so I feel sure there is not only room but a decided need at this time for business women to join hands in a club."

At the convention of the newly organized National Federation of Professional and Business Women's Clubs and the Women's Association of Commerce in St. Louis, Mo., this week, a dispute developed among the delegates over the part the national Y. W. C. A. is taking in the affairs of the federation. It was claimed by delegates of the Women's Association of Commerce that the Y. W. C. A. is trying to dominate the new organization. Prominent Y. W. C. A. women stoutly denied this charge. There is a movement in Philadelphia to establish a women's chamber of commerce here and it is probable the club will be in working order this winter. No local clubs, however, have joined the National Federation of Professional and Business Women's Clubs.

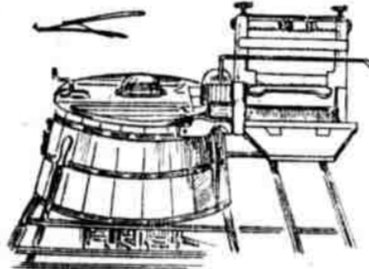
