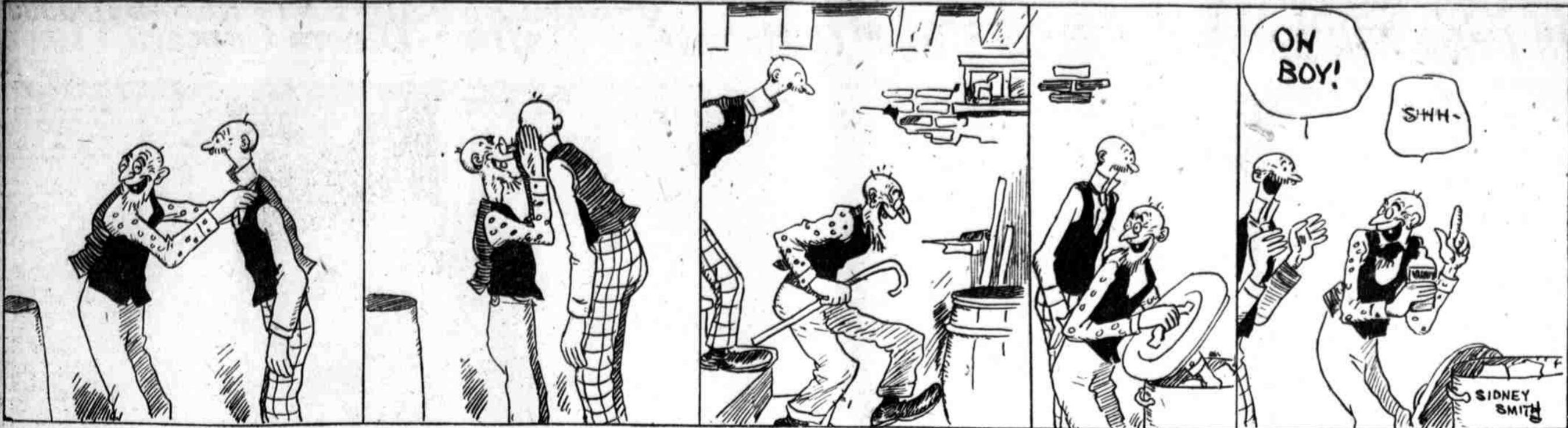

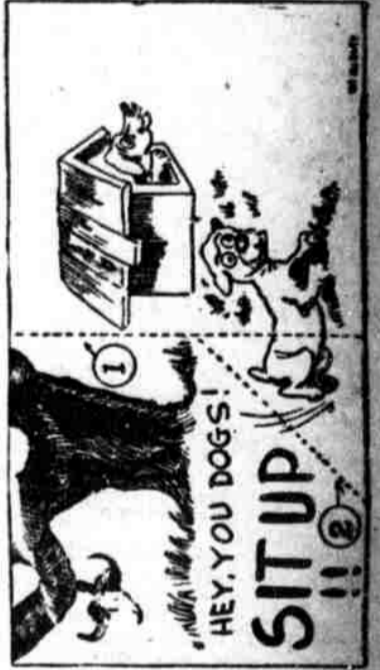

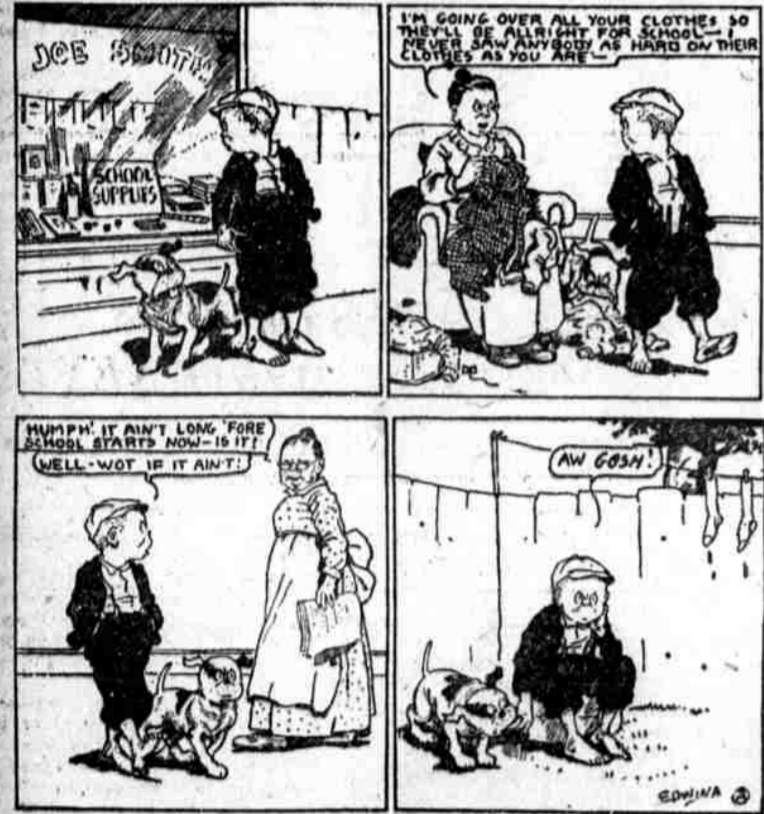
MOVING PICTURE FUNNIES

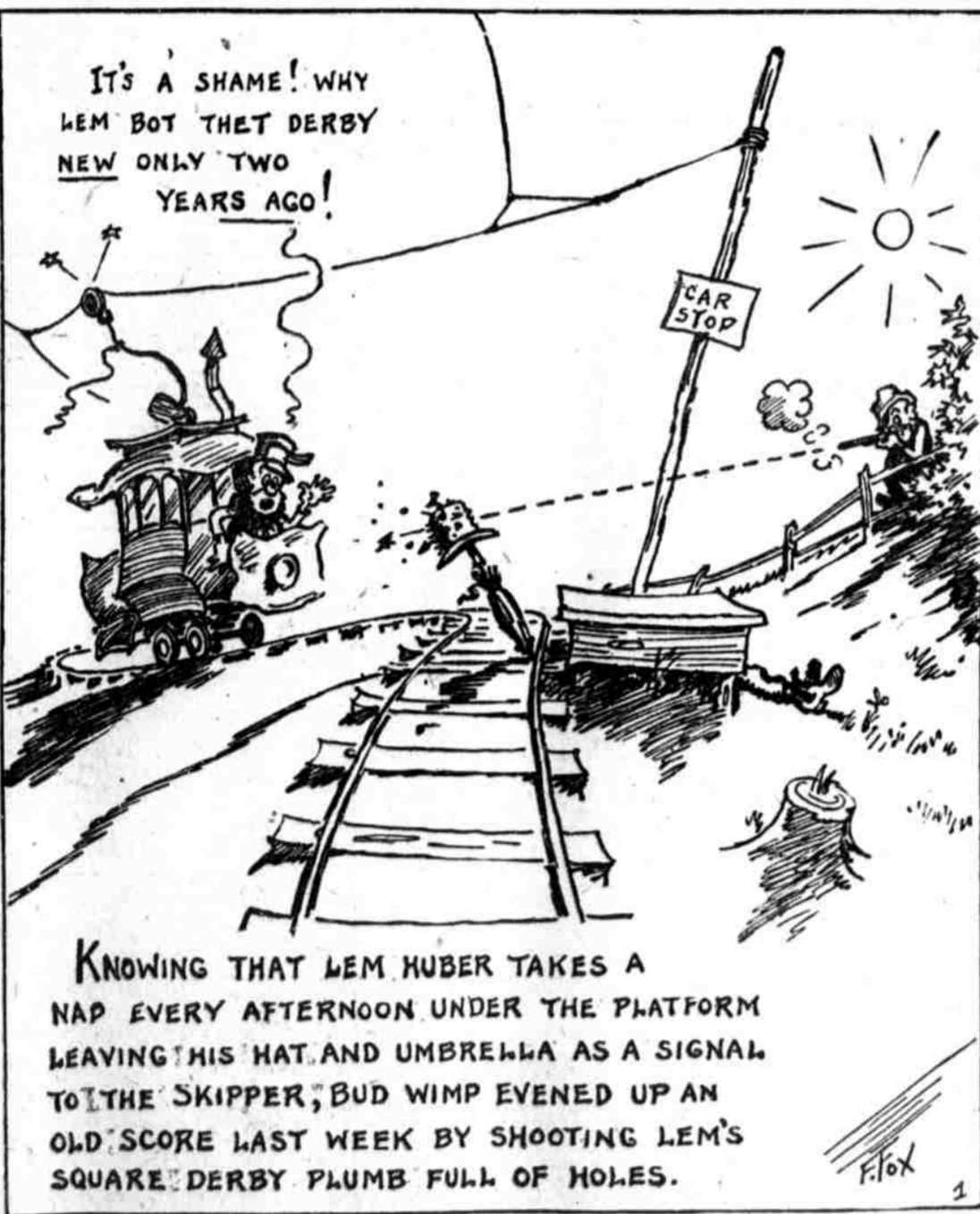
