

PRELIMINARY SORTIE DI FIUME

Accettera' il Compromesso Preparato dall'Italia, Francia e Inghilterra

Washington, D. C., 4 settembre.—Una viva aspettativa regna in questi giorni per i piani relativi al compromesso raggiunto tra i governi italiano, inglese e francese per la sistemazione della questione di Fiume, piani che dovranno essere immediatamente sottoposti al Presidente Wilson per la sua approvazione.

La nota collettiva che i tre governi predetti hanno deliberato di inviare al Presidente Wilson, non ha ancora raggiunto il Dipartimento di Stato e non si conosce se sarà presentata dall'ambasciatore italiano qui, o, come usualmente si è fatto dopo il ritorno del Presidente da Parigi, sia presentata a mezzo dell'ambasciatore americano.

Il Dipartimento di Stato è stato informato dei piani del compromesso per la sistemazione di Fiume e vi è ragione di credere che il Presidente Wilson c'

propone ad accettare le linee generali del compromesso sulla predetta città. Secondo quanto si è potuto apprendere riguardo al detto compromesso, in città di Fiume non sarebbe annessa né all'Italia né alla Jugoslavia, ma la sua Italia: verrebbe riconosciuta al governo della città, si approssimerebbe a quanto è stato deciso dalla Conferenza della Pace per il bacino del Saar e per il porto di Danzica.

I piani per la sistemazione di Fiume, si dice, si approssimano allo scema favorito dal Presidente Wilson, quando si parla di una conferenza della Pace e che di Wm. Orlando rigetto.

Parigi, 4 settembre.—Il Supremo Conflitto ha deciso di mandare un ultimatum al governo Rumeno riguardo le sue operazioni in Ungheria.

L'ultimatum sarebbe redatto in termini severi ed impone un limitato termine e sarà consegnato da un inviato del Supremo Consiglio. Se la Rumenia si rifiuta di ottemperare alle richieste degli alleati, entro il termine fissato, le relazioni diplomatiche cesseranno e gli inviati alleati Bucarest saranno ritirati insieme ai rappresentanti diplomatici.

Il testo dell'ultimatum non sarà fatto noto fino a che non sarà consegnato al governo rumeno. Si apprende che l'ultimatum principalmente riguarda le riparazioni e l'evacuazione dell'Ungheria.
