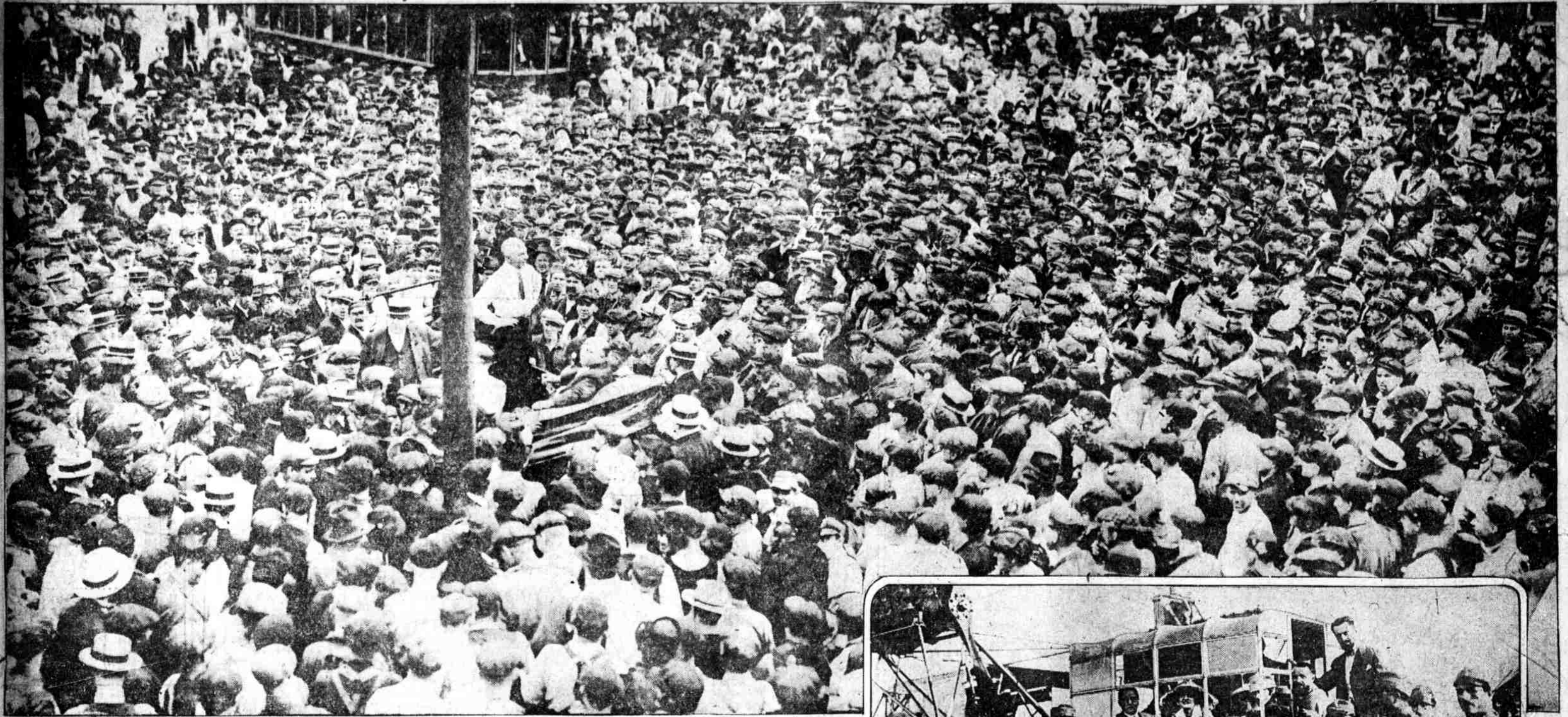
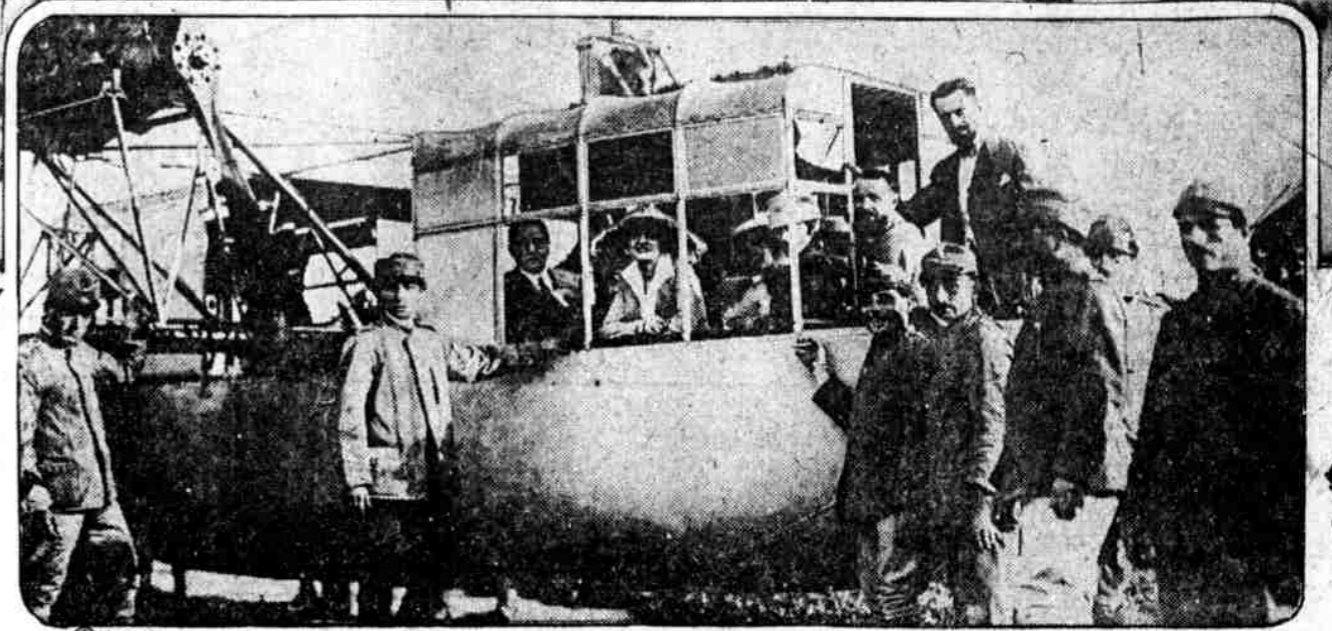


Urging Shipworkers to Rid City of Contractor Rule at Republican Alliance Meeting

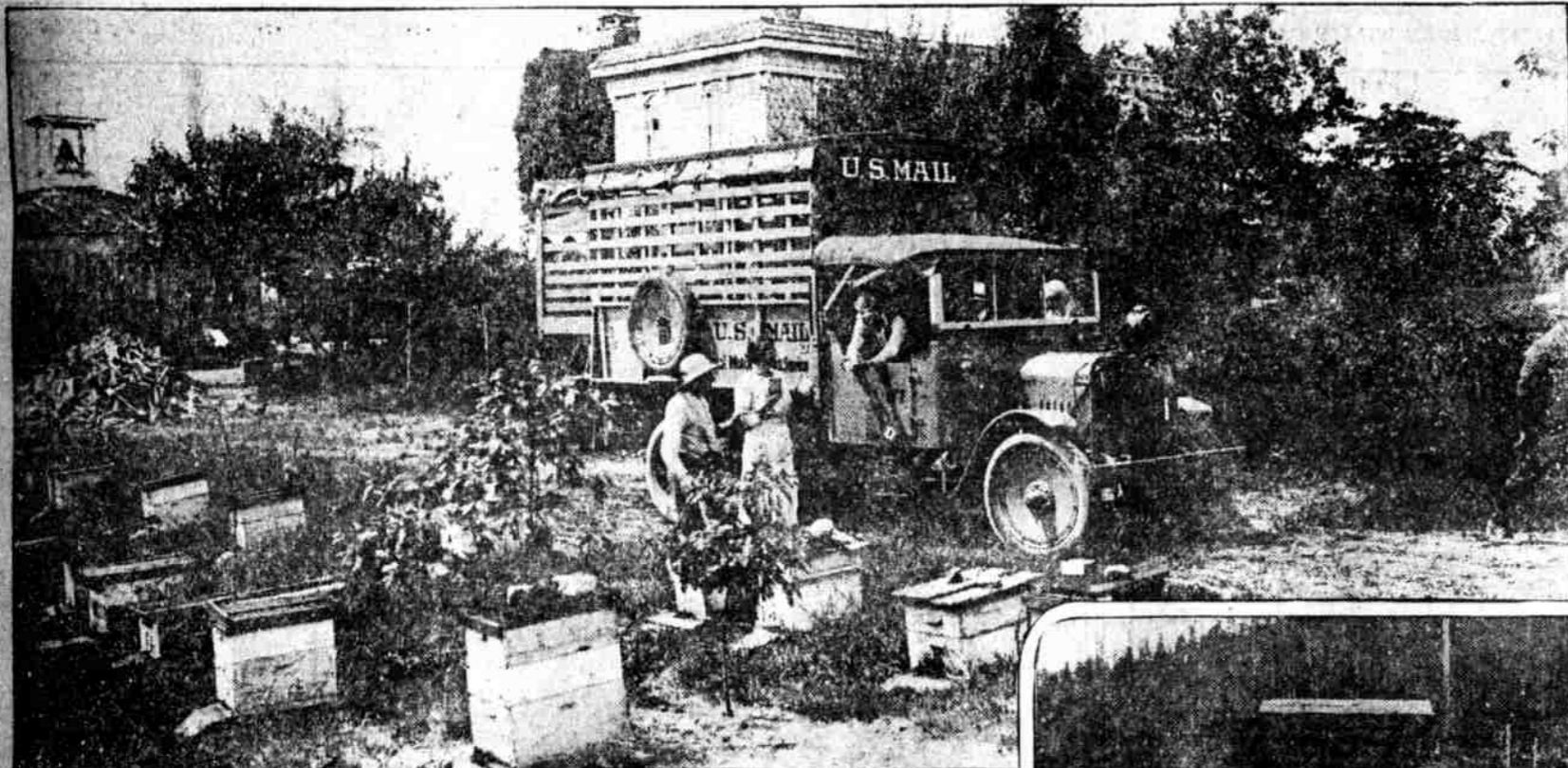
