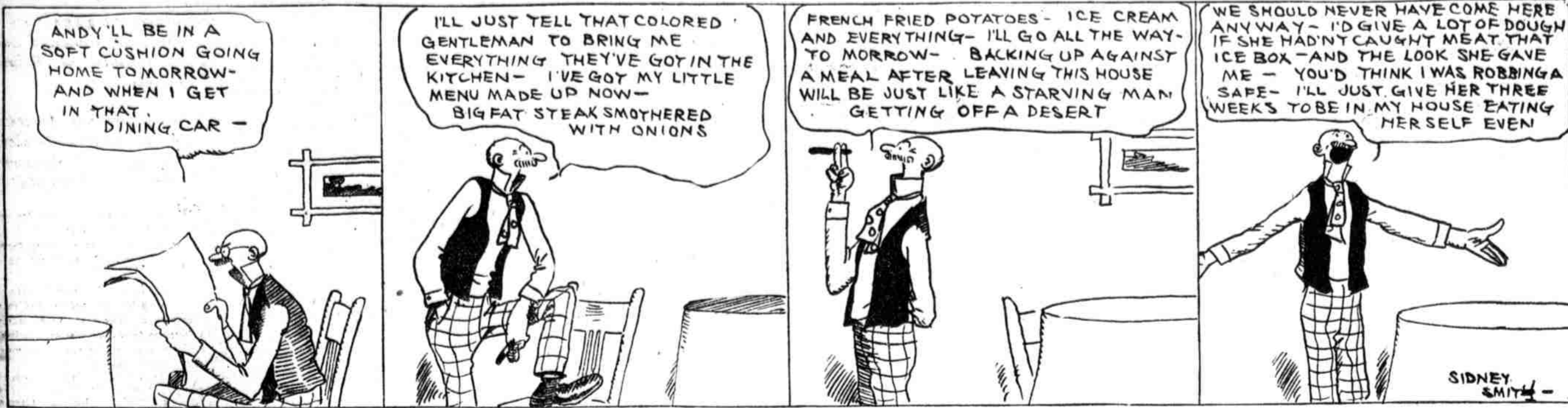

The Young Lady Across the Way



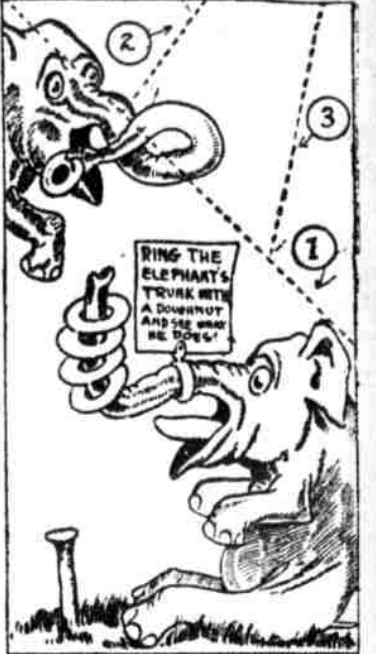
The young lady across the way says circumstances alter cases and probably George Washington would have transmitted his message to Congress by cable if he'd happened to be abroad at the time.

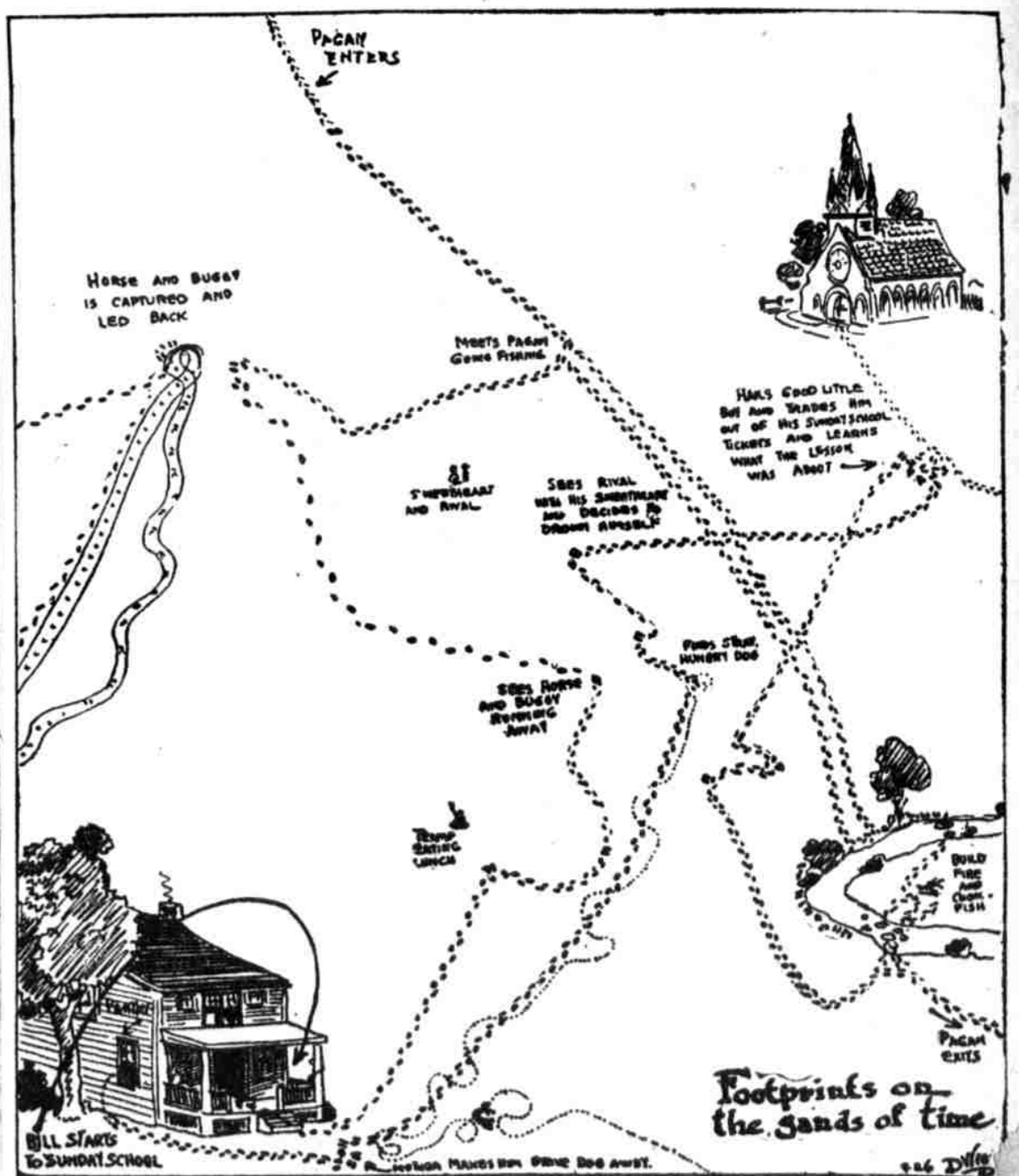
