Seven-teenth and Grayson streets; the Web-ster, Howard street and Girard avenue; and the Franklin, at Fox Chase. Ninety-one sewing teachers were given a \$100 advance on their yearly salary yesterday and classed as gram-mar grasie teachers on the school hoard's payroll.


