

MAY DROP SCHOOL LUNCHES

Superintendent Says Money Provided Won't Equip Kitchens
School children of Philadelphia may be deprived of luncheon service in school buildings owing to the discovery that it will cost in excess of the \$100 each allowed by the school board to outfit kitchens in the public schools.
This announcement was made yesterday by Dr. John P. Garber, superintendent of schools, at a meeting of the committee on elementary schools in the Keystone Building.
Schools for which kitchen equipment is asked are the Henry, Carpenter and Greene streets; the Mitchell, Thirty-fifth street and Fairmount avenue; the Central High Annex, Lincoln, Seventh and Grayson streets; the Webster, Howard street and Girard avenue; and the Franklin, at Fox Chase.
Ninety-one sewing teachers were given a \$100 advance on their yearly salary yesterday and classed as grammar grade teachers on the school board's payroll.

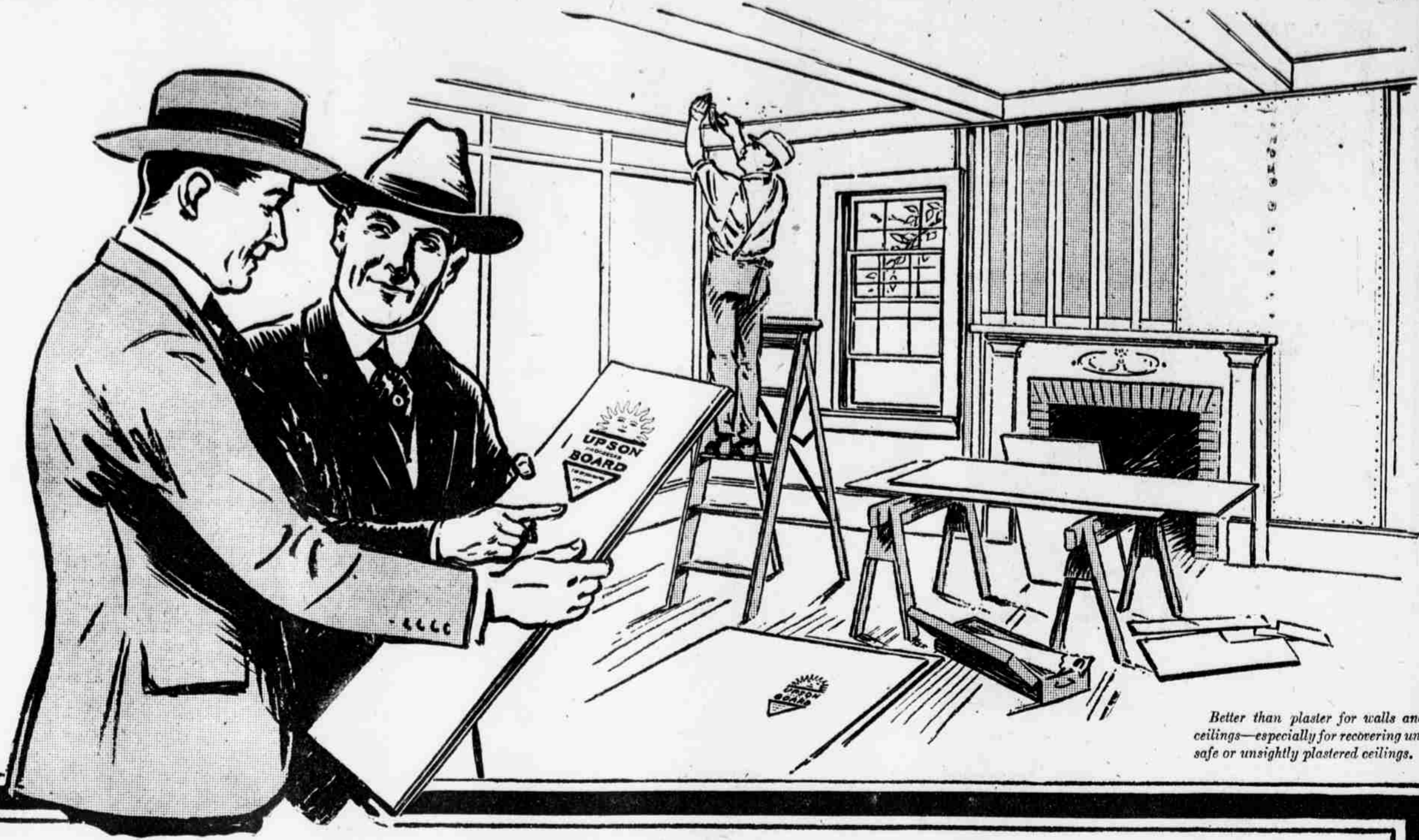
