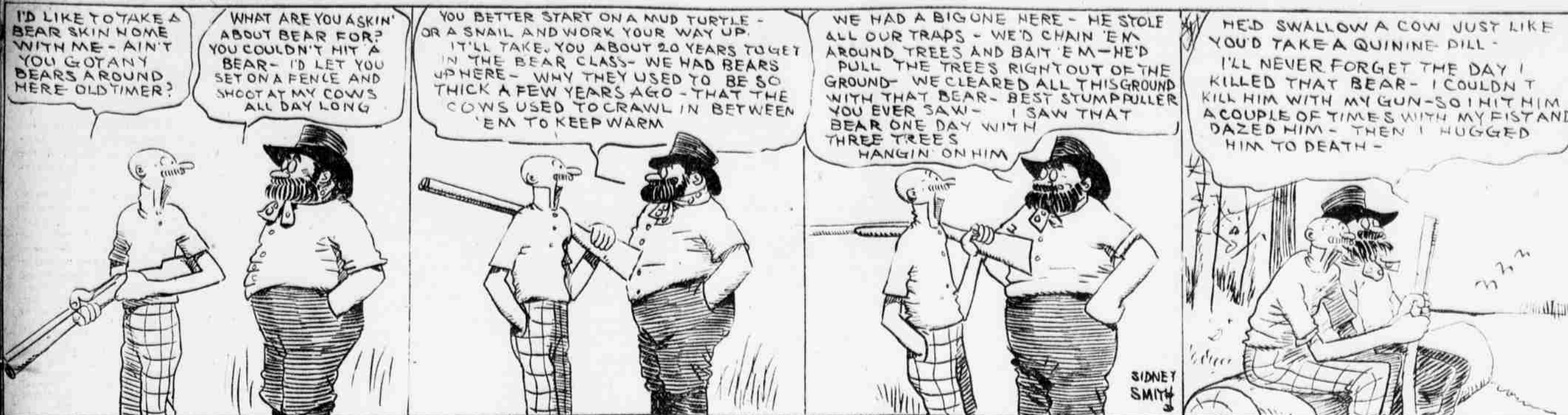

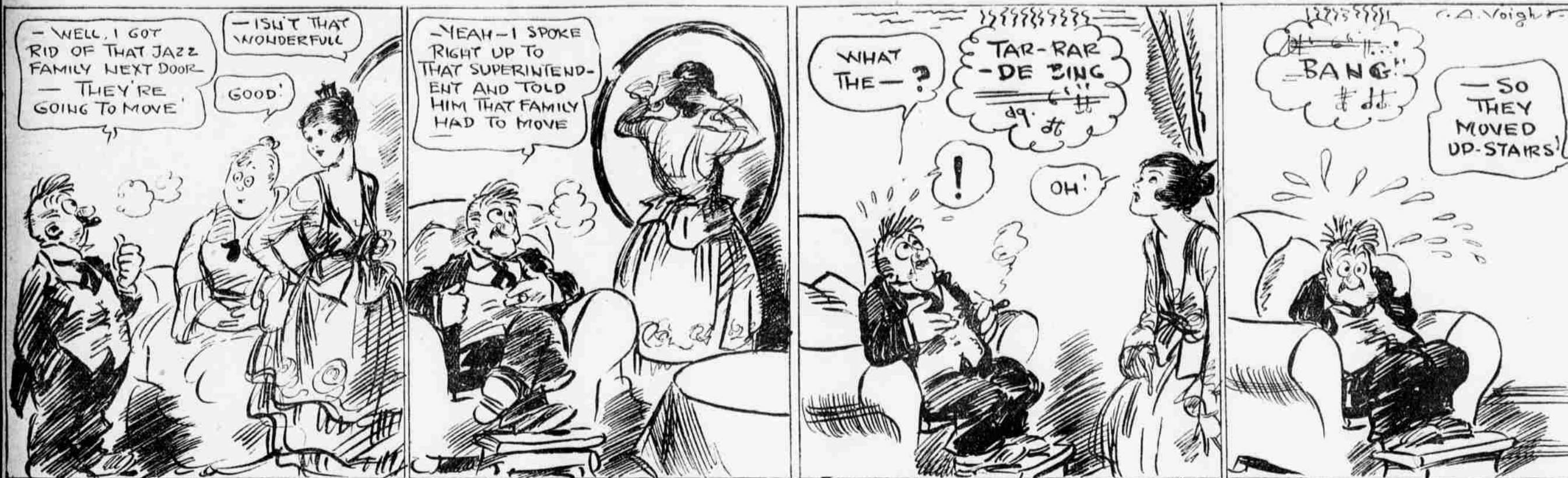

MOVING PICTURE FUNNIES



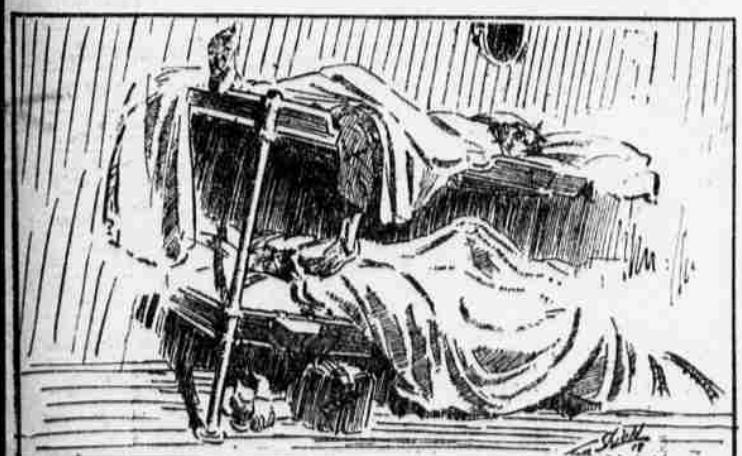
