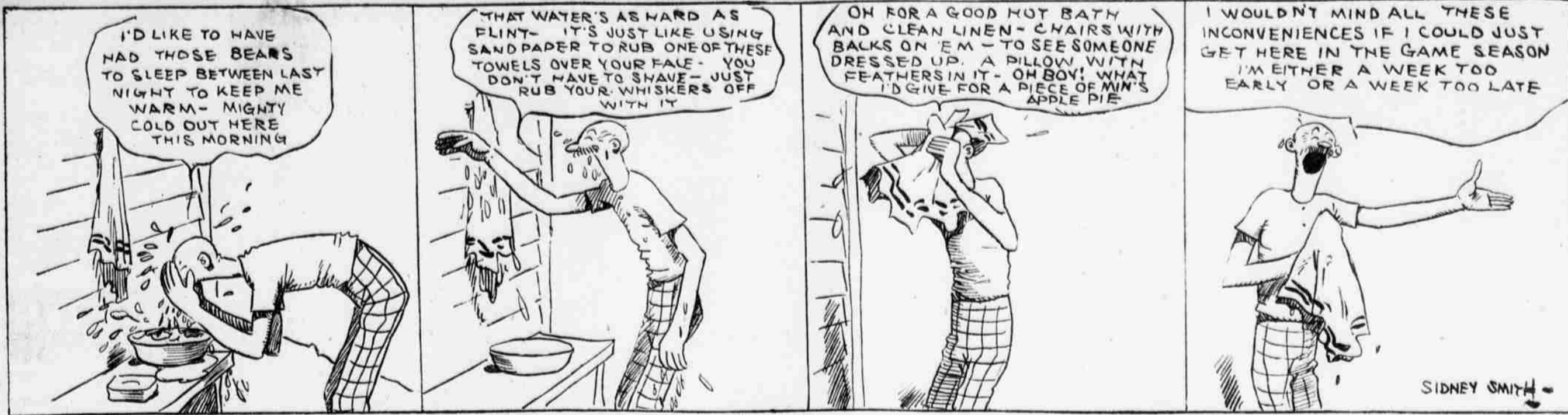

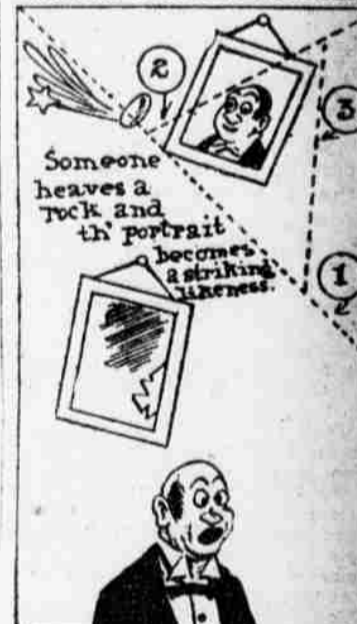
The young lady across the way says the government ought to set us all a good example in the matter of saving and what we need in this country is more political economy.

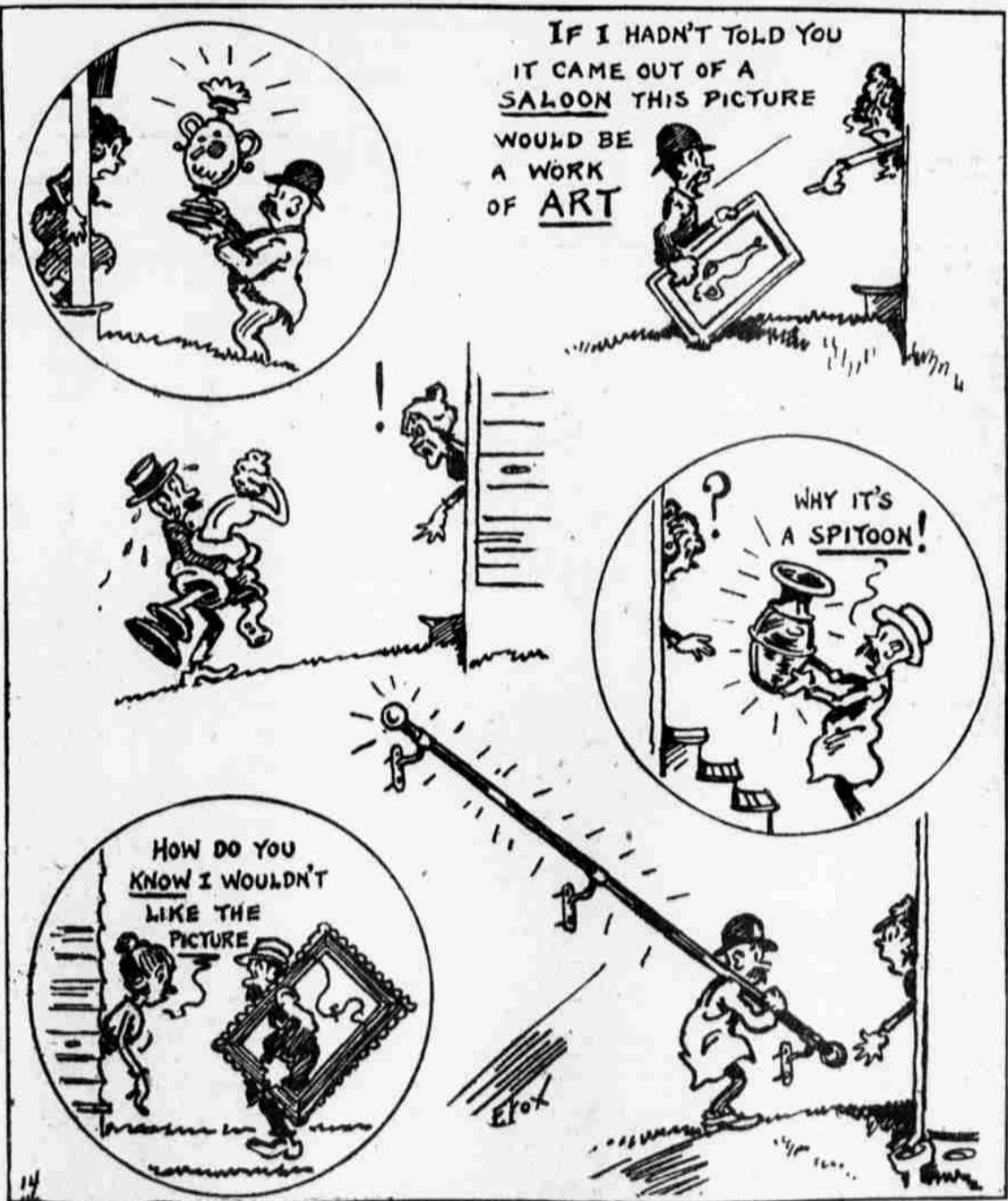
