

**LAW SATISFIES LIQUOR FOE**

Anti-Saloon Lawyer Says It Can Be Strengthened Later

Wayne B. Wheeler, attorney for the Anti-Saloon League of America, issued a statement today in which he declared that while the new prohibition enforcement act is not as strong as the league wished it to be, it can be made airtight later if the need should arise.

"The bill is strong enough to destroy the beverage traffic in liquor," said Wheeler. "If the non-beverage makers and sellers of alcoholic preparations abuse the privileges granted to them, it will result in additional legislation. The law will never be made weaker."

"The weak points of the bill from the viewpoint of the Anti-Saloon League are found in some of the restrictions made for non-beverage liquor and the large discretion given the courts in the fines and imprisonment."
