By the Associated Press. Fiume, Nov. 14.—Food is now coming to Fiume regularly over the railway from Trieste. Congressional relations with the outside world have begun. The Italian Government has finally decided to allow the blockade. The opening of sea traffic has raised the specter of work in the harbor as well as in some Fiume industries. There have been no strikes since the occupation by the forces of Italian troops.

MISS TROY CAN'T RETURN

England Won't Receive American Woman Deported as "Undesirable". London, Nov. 14.—Replying to a question in the House of Commons as to whether Lillian Scott Troy would be allowed to return to England, Home Secretary Short said she had been deported as an undesirable alien and that for the same reason she would not be allowed to return.

Miss Lillian Scott Troy, of San Francisco, arrived in New York last April after being deported. She ground for objection to her passage in England was said to have been that she had worked to obtain the release of Baron Louis von Helldorf, interned by the British government in 1917. She was an assistant in the management of his company.
