

MILLIONS ASKED FOR CITY POSTS

Many Departments Want New Places Made and Old Salaries Advanced

WOULD TAX TREASURY

Millions for salary boosts and new jobs have been asked of Council's finance committee by city and county department heads.

Harry W. Kelly, chief clerk for Receiver of Taxes Kendrick, started the ball rolling last evening when he asked for a general increase in wages for the men of his office and for the creation of a new \$4500 place for an assistant.

This is one of the offices which have followed and free from Civil Service.

William J. Beahm, deputy of Recorder of Deeds Hazlett, is asking creation of seventy-five new jobs at \$1500 a year each in addition to many salary increases.

This is another office under Vane control and free from direction from the Mayor's office.

The county commissioners have carried the demand for salary increases, turned down by the Legislature to the finance committee. It granted it will provide for births at good salaries for many Vane adherents who may lose out as the result of changes due to a change in the city administration.

The commissioners want to increase their investigating staff by a new supervisor, a deputy and six additional children's agents. They are also demanding salary increases for the Vane placers in the Bureau of Weights and Measures.

Representing the city treasurer, George W. Morrison, chief clerk, has asked the finance committee to create new jobs in that office and to increase the salary of a number of men now employed.

These demands, coming from county offices on top of the plans for spending \$1,750,000 to \$2,000,000 in increases for the police and firemen, bring the total for increases and new places to a figure millions in advance of any authorization of a similar character ever included in any annual budget.

The municipal departmental budgets, as distinguished from the county offices, will be taken up, it has been announced by Chairman Gaffney, only after the wishes of Mayor-elect Moore are made known.

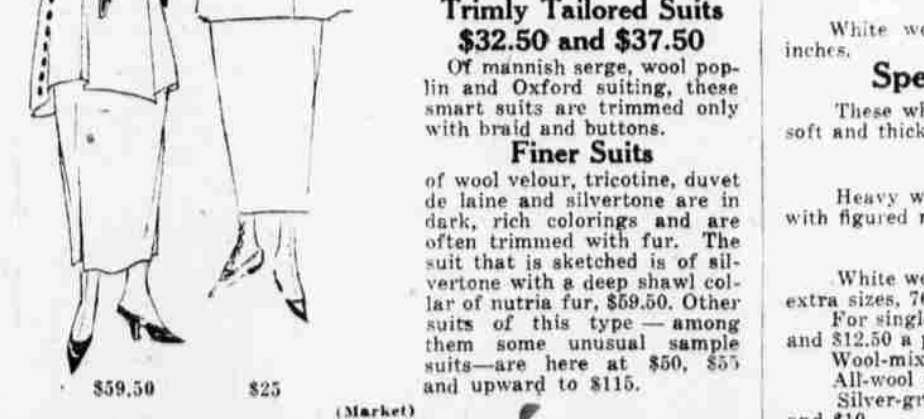
