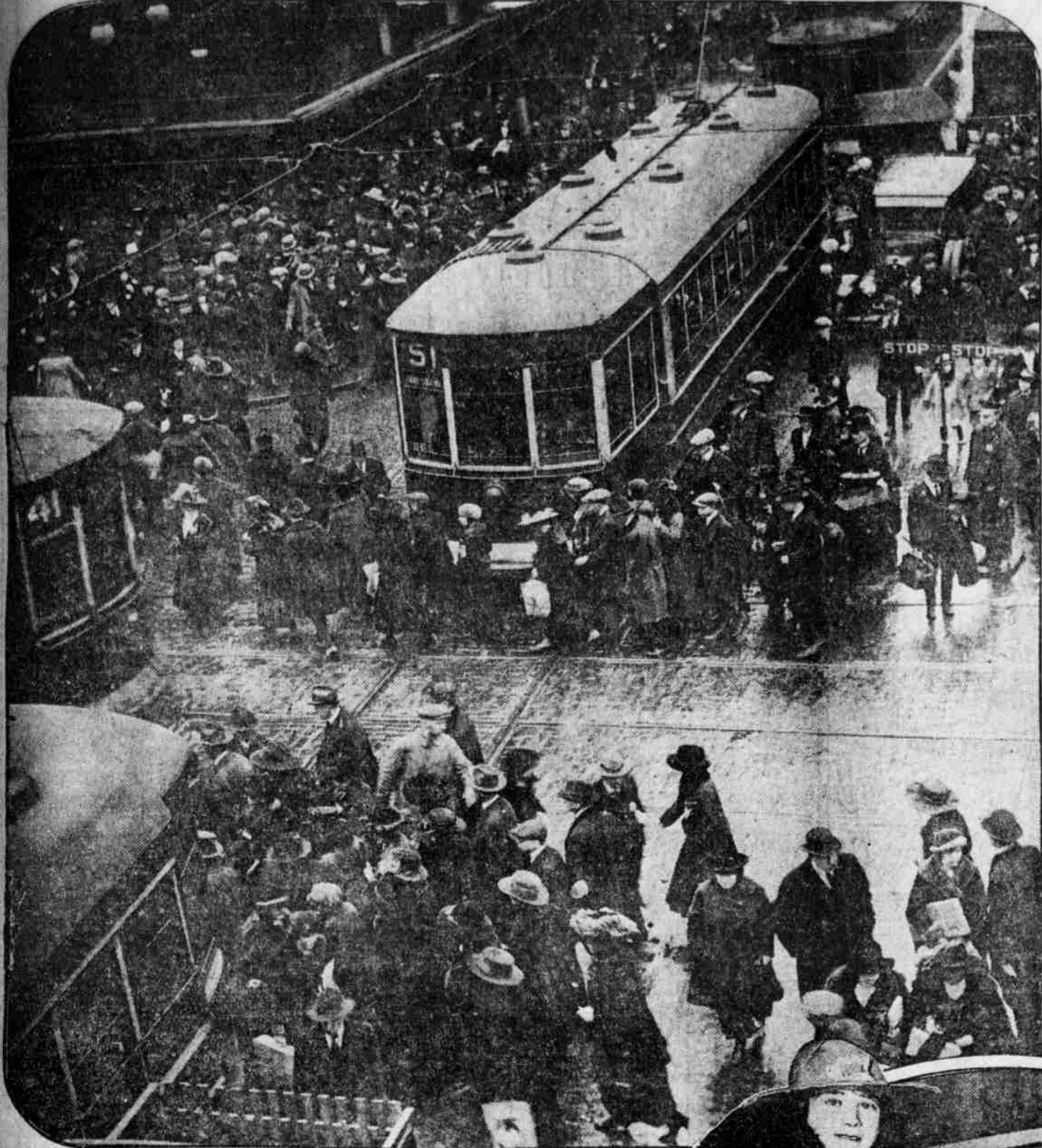


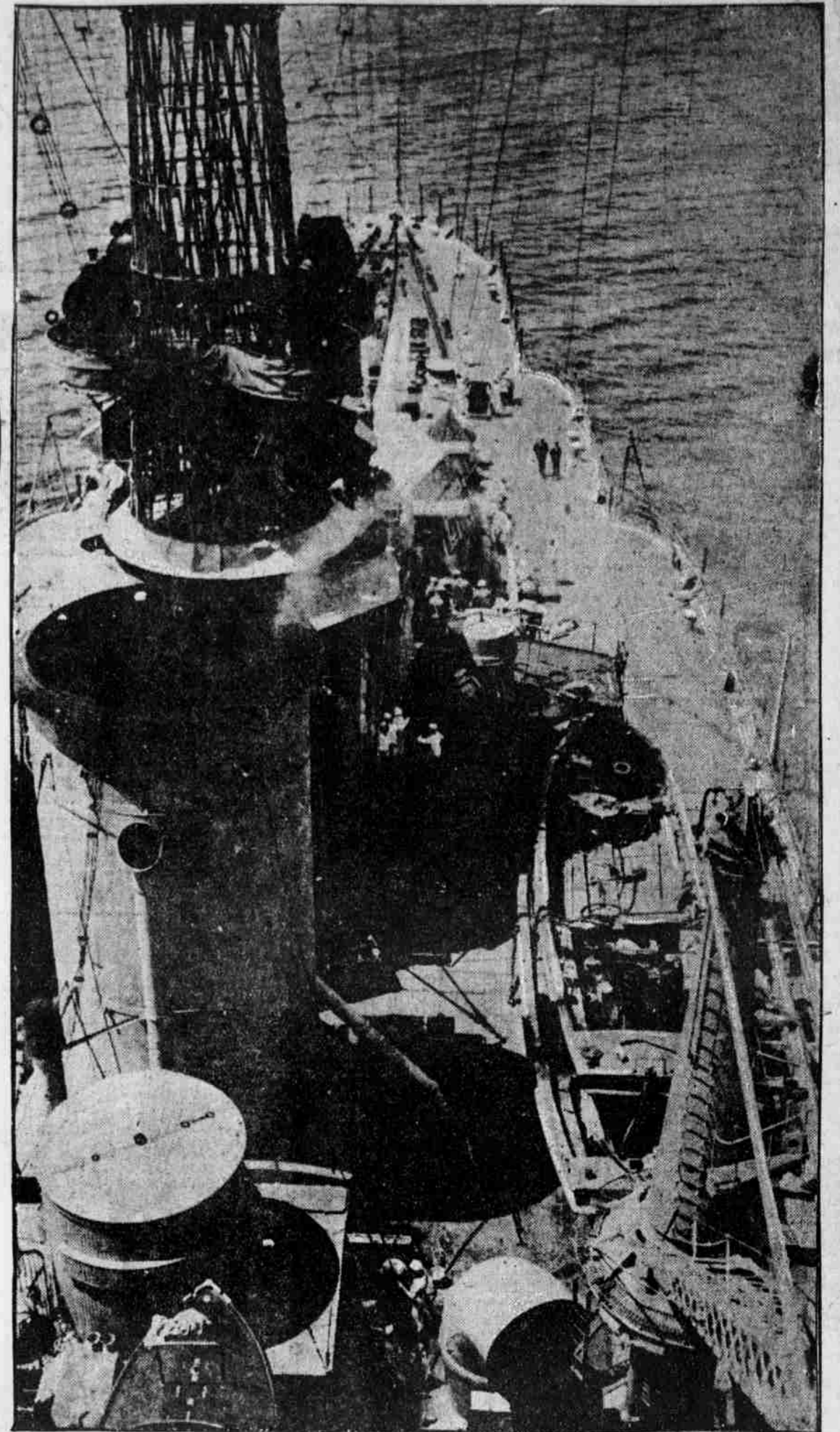

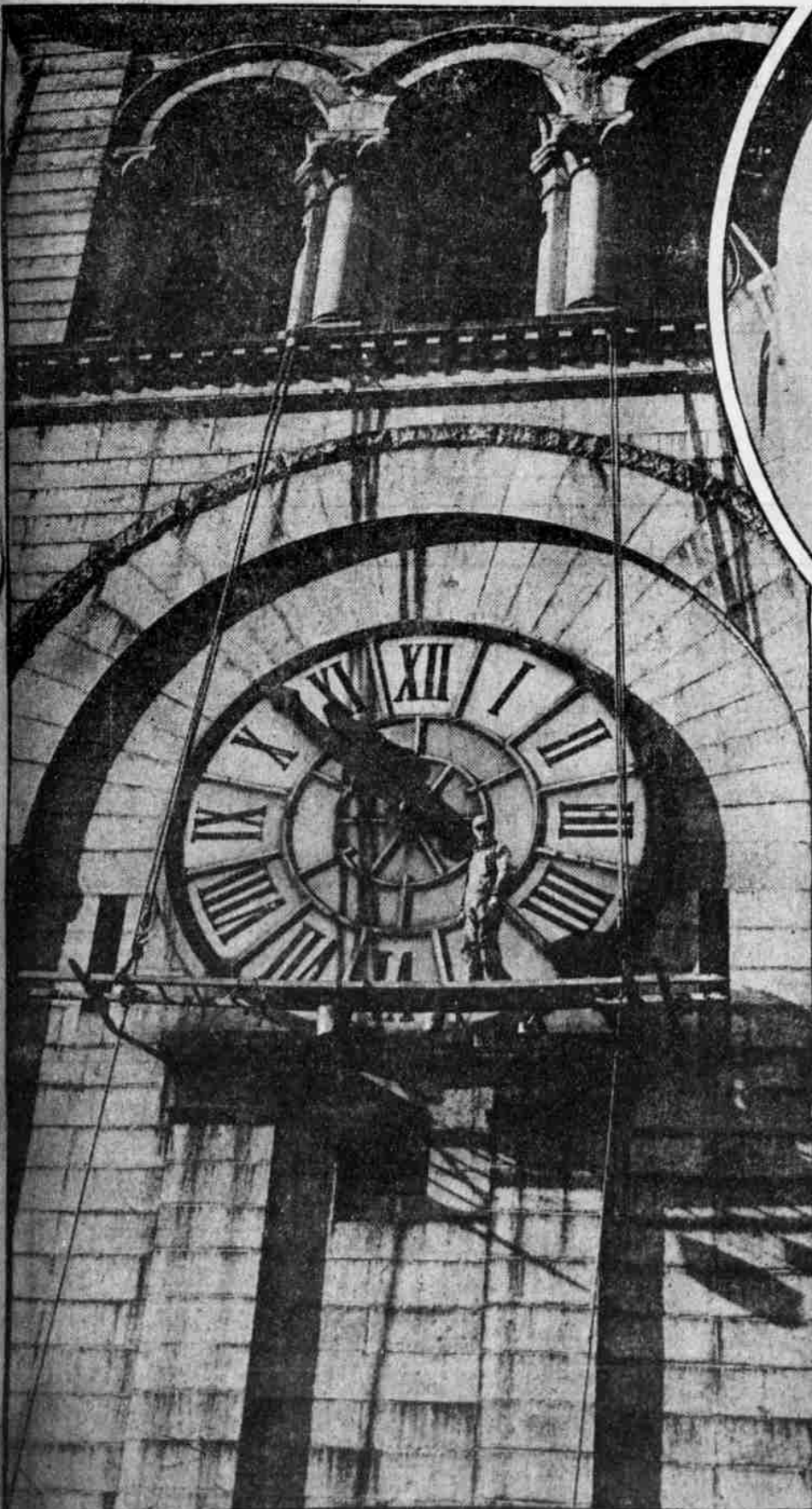

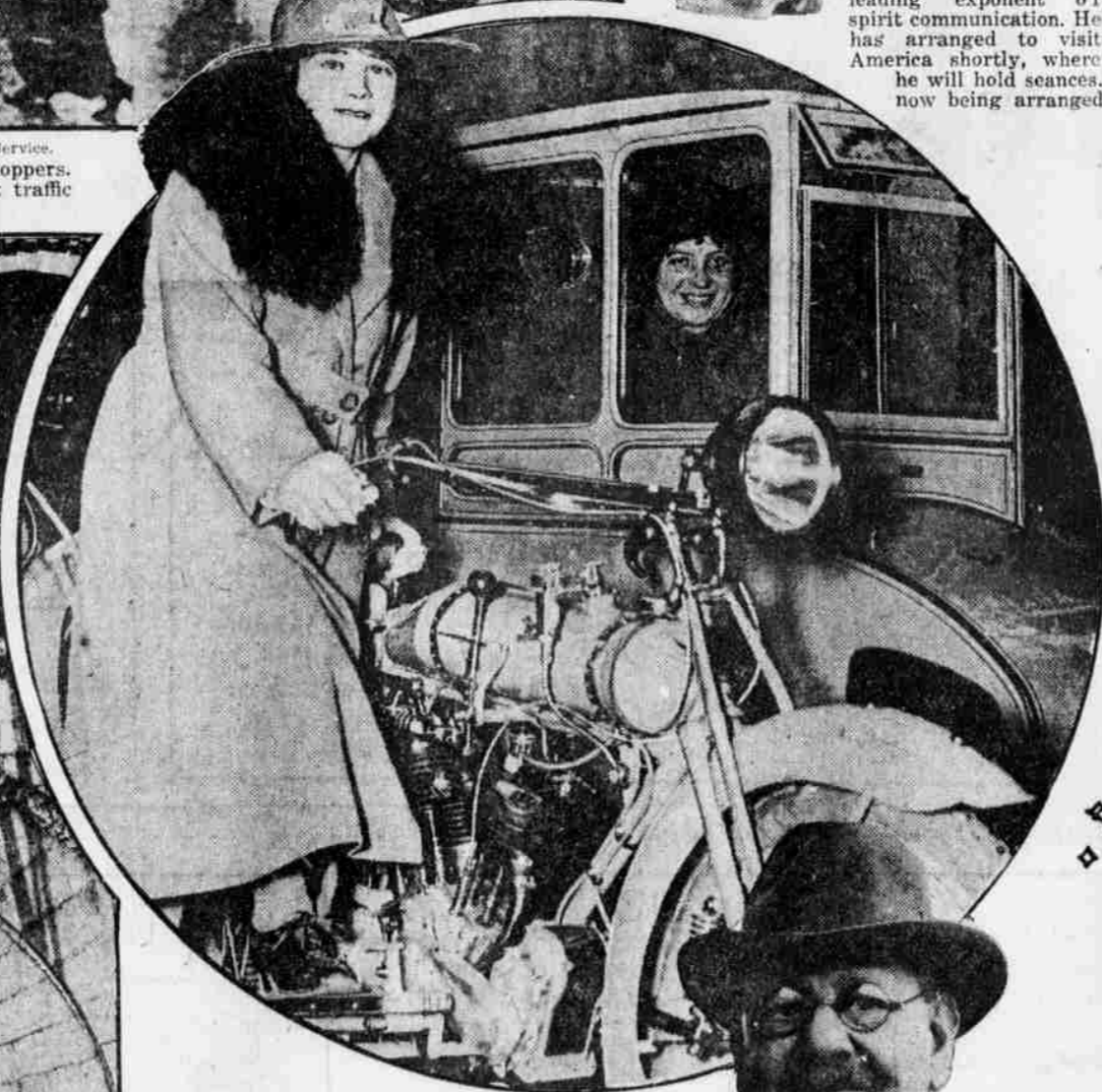
SIR OLIVER LODGE, leading exponent of spirit communication. He has arranged to visit America shortly, where he will hold seances, now being arranged
