

**CARDINALS GIVEN RED HATS BY POPE**

Elaborate Ceremonies in Sistine Chapel at Creation of Seven New Princes of Church

Rome, Dec. 19. — The pope yesterday conducted a public consistory at which were present the whole ecclesiastical, civil and papal courts, besides the diplomatic body of Roman aristocracy.

the Knights of Malta and many distinguished visitors. Dressed in his full pontifical robes and the red cape, the pope was carried into the consistory presence in the sedia gestatoria. In addition to the high dignitaries of his court the pope was accompanied by all the cardinals residing at Rome as well as some who came from the provinces for the ceremony. All the new cardinals took the oath in the Sistine Chapel except the archbishop of Saragossa, to whom the red beretta of the cardinalate was sent through Monsignor Somma, the papal ablegate. The ritual embrace of the whole sa-

ered college was accorded to the new cardinals, including Monsignor Bertram, archbishop of Breslau; Monsignor Camassei, former patriarch of Jerusalem; Monsignor Sili, vice chairman of the church; Monsignor Valfrido di Bouso, former nuncio at Vienna; Monsignor Kakowski, archbishop of Warsaw, and Monsignor Dalbor, archbishop of Posen. After the ritual embrace the pope imposed upon them the red hat. To the two new Polish cardinals the pope said: "The Holy See has always taken a great interest in the restoration of your nation and is exultant today because of your freedom."

The pontiff recalled the incident when Pius IX. preserved one of the cardinals in the ceremony of the canonization of a Polish saint and gave it to the Polish ecclesiastical college in Rome, telling them to keep it until it could be taken to Warsaw when Poland had regained its freedom. "It was a prophetic spirit," said the pope, "and today, after fifty years, that candle can be taken to Warsaw by you, cardinals of Poland." The whole sacred college then adjourned to the Sistine Chapel, where they prayed, prostrated before the altar, while the choir sang the Te Deum.
