Systematic Bear Drives, Successful Against Individual Groups, Collectively Failed to Hit the Mark

New York, Feb. 9.—Today's stock market virtually resolved itself into a battle between the long and short interests. The contented movement between the forces of the professional trading contingent produced both a feverish and confusing price movement.

Such a ragged and bewildering banking market was to be expected after last week's violent fluctuations. The general feeling seemingly had an undertone of considerable strength.

Little advantage was offered either of the continuing news in the morning. If anything matters in general slightly favored the constructive side.
