

Uniform Wage Scale

uniform wage scale shall be established so that the various occupa-tions of like character at several col-lieries shall command the same wage.

lieries shall command the same wage. Shovel crews for coal companies shall be paid not less than the rates paid by the contractors to shovel men. "A work day of not more than six hours from bank to bapk shall be es-tablished for all classes of inside and outside day labor, five days a week. The uniform scales shall be the basis upon which the advance above demanded shall apply, with time and a half for overtime and double time for Sundays and holidays.


