

WANTS TO OCCUPY TURKISH CAPITAL

Massacre of Armenians Is Expected to Result in Drastic Treaty Alterations

ISLAM ASKS PROBE BY U. S.

By the Associated Press London, March 6.—The Daily Telegraph today makes a feature of a report that the Allies have decided on the military and naval occupation of Constantinople in consequence of the treatment of the Armenians by the Turks.

The newspaper's version of the report represents Great Britain as determined to occupy the Turkish capital and says she has invited France and Italy to co-operate and that their replies are awaited.

British forces in the Mesopotamia all regions, particularly near Keruk and Mosul, have been engaged in constant skirmishes with tribesmen and Turkish irregulars. Recognition of the Armenian republic without defining its boundaries embittered the Turks in Cilicia.

The horrors of Armenian massacres and deportations during the great struggle are blandly met with the statement that the Turkish army suffered at the hands of Armenians.

There is likelihood that the Cilician massacre will cost Turkey much of what the treaty of peace would otherwise have left her. In addition, the Armenians in inner circles at Whitehall, where allied foreign ministers continue framing the Turkish settlement.

The proposed western boundary from Enos on the Aegean sea to Vidia, on the Black sea, may be abandoned and the line may be drawn much further east. This would limit Turkish possessions in Europe to the narrow peninsula north of the Sea of Marmora.

Paris, March 6.—(By A. P.)—Complete agreement on features of the Turkish treaty has been reached, says Ferdinand, political editor of Echo de Paris, who adds that the operation of the Turkish financial control commission will be quite distinct from the administration of the Ottoman debt.

The Supreme Council, he says, is about to take up the establishment of a judicial commission and definitely settle conditions to be accorded Greece, Italy, France and Great Britain in Asia Minor. While the Allies would respect the "open door principle," they would enjoy rights of priority regarding economic concessions, he says.

Japan has informed the council of ambassadors that she recognizes Armenia as a de facto government.

Constantinople, March 6.—(By A. P.)—Resolutions asking the United States to send a commission to impartially investigate the Marash massacre and conditions in Cilicia, were passed unanimously today by the Turkish Chamber of Deputies. This action followed an address by Arif Bey today was elected president of the Chamber, succeeding Rehad Kismet Bey, deceased.
