

BAIRD TO SUPPORT EDGE AND STOKES

Camden Leader Agrees to Both Jersey Senators on "Big Four"

RAYMOND IN OTHER PLACE

Trenton, March 11.—Confirming the expectations of Republican leaders last week that David Baird, former United States senator, of Camden, would make clear his views in the "big four" controversy, Mr. Baird at the conclusion of a conference in the Republican Club here announced he would support United States Senators Edge and Frelinghuysen in their candidacies for delegates-at-large to the Republican national convention in Chicago. It was also announced that the Camden county leader and his supporters would support Chairman Edward C. Stokes, of the Republican state committee, as the third member of the "big four."

The declaration made by Mr. Baird followed a conference attended by Commissioner Thomas L. Raymond, of Newark; Chairman Frank E. Davenport, of the Essex county Republican committee; Frank F. Patterson, county clerk of Camden; Fred J. Stone, of Newark.
