FIRE RAZES HUME;

Gloucester Dwelling and Barbershop Lost as Owners Attend Christening Here

BODY SOUGHT IN THE RUINS

Fire at 2 o'clock this morning destroyed the home and barber shop of Joseph Spinuzzi at 209 Jersey avenue. Gloucester, driving a score of persons to the street in their nightclothes, endangering surrounding property and

dangering surrounding property and causing a loss of \$5000.

While the fire raged through the two-story frame building Spinuzzi, his wife and children were in Philadelphia making merry at a christening.

They returned to Gloucester this morning to find their home and the barber shop a mass of smoking embers. Firemen are raking the ruins to find a man, said to have been seen on the a man, said to have been seen on the second floor of the burning home just before the roof collapsed.

The fire was not discovered until it burst from rear windows of the second floor. By that time it was sweeping through the structure from north to

Adjoining the building is the boarding house of Mrs. Paul Salles. The intense heat and smoke awoke the occupants of the boarding place, and fifteen men, employed at the shippards, hurried to the street, carrying their clothes and presents belongings.

With the collapse of the roof, flames from the Spinuzzi Building bridged the gap and ignited the Salles house.

A telephone call was sent to the Camden Fire Department, and Engine Company. No. 3, in command of Captain Chambers and Battalion Chief Thomas Nichols, was hurried to Gloucester.

Sparks from the blaze ignited the roof of the home of Michael Coyle, at King street and Jersey avenue, but by hard work firemen succeeded in pre-venting its destruction.
