THREAT OF GENERAL STRIKE SHORE POST AGAINST BONUS

Copenhagen, March 30,-King Christian announced today his refusal to comply with the ultimatum of the Social Democrats demanding the reinstatement of the Zahle ministry, dismissed by the king, and other action in connection

with the government crisis.

Besides demanding restoration of the Zable cabinet, Socialists and trade union representatives, who conferred with the king last night, insisted on avimmediate call for a meeting of the Rigsdad and the introduction once more of the constitutional conditions of the

Declarations were made that if these demands were rejected all Danish trade unions would call a meeting today with a view to declaring a general strike. Crowds gathered in the public squares last night, and up to an early hour today raised cries for the establishtoday raised cries for the establishment of a republican form of government for Denmark. Slight disturbances occurred while soldiers were occupying one of the squares and cries of "Long live the republic!" were heard during the night.
