

# KING OF DENMARK REFUSES DEMANDS

### Will Not Reinstate Zahle Ministry Despite Clarification

### THREAT OF GENERAL STRIKE

Copenhagen, March 29.—King Christian announced today his refusal to comply with the ultimatum of the Social Democrats demanding the reinstatement of the Zahle ministry, dismissed by the king, and other action in connection with the government crisis.

Besides demanding restoration of the Zahle cabinet, Socialists and trade union representatives, who conferred with the king last night, insisted on an immediate call for a meeting of the Rigsdag and the introduction of a bill of the constitutional conditions of the country.

Declarations were made that if these demands were rejected all Danish trade unions would call a meeting today with a view to declaring a general strike.

Crowds gathered in the public squares last night, and up to an early hour today raised cries for the establishment of a republican form of government for Denmark. Slight disturbances occurred while soldiers were occupying one of the squares and cries of "Long live the republic" were heard during the night. All streets leading to the royal palace are held by the police.

M. Rosing, one of the ministers in the new cabinet formed by M. Liebe to

take the place of the Zahle ministry, was reported as saying the new government intended holding election before summoning the Parliament to consider the question of Flensburg, the principal town in the second plebiscite zone.

The crisis arose over the disposition of the second Schleswig zone, which the Zahle ministry considered settled in favor of Germany by the recent plebiscite. The opposition, however, insisted there should be at least provisional internationalization of Flensburg and the second zone. M. Rosing declared the new ministry would endeavor to secure the internationalization of the second zone, including Flensburg.
