

UN TRATTATO TRA ITALIA E ARGENTINA

Le Due Nazioni si Preparano al Libero Scambio di Generi Alimentari

Buenos Aires, 30 Marzo.—Si e' oggi appreso che tra l'Italia e l'Argentina e in corso un trattato per il libero scambio delle derrate alimentari. Il trattato sara' firmato entro pochi giorni dal Presidente Irigoyen, dell'Argentina, e da Vittorio C. Cobianchi, ministro plenipotenziario dell'Italia. Sembra che siano in corso negoziati per un simile trattato con il Giappone e che il Ministro del Portogallo ha anch'esso consensito al riguardo, nell'interesse della sua nazione.

Detti negoziati sono il risultato della proposta fatta dall'Argentina lo scorso ottobre a tutte le nazioni, quella cioè di rimuovere tutte le tariffe sui prodotti alimentari di prima necessita', allo scopo di poter ridurre l'alto costo della vita attraverso il mondo.

Una clausola del trattato stipulato con l'Italia, prevede che le due nazioni dovranno invitare tutti i governi del mondo a sottoscrivere trattati simili. Se il trattato suddetto sara' approvato dai legislatori dei due paesi, altre nazioni, specialmente dell'Europa, si affretteranno ad accettare l'invito.

I generi che verranno scambiati tra l'Argentina e l'Italia sono principalmente il riso, la carne, grano, fieno, latte, burro, pesce conservato, vegetali e zucchero.

Roma, 29 Marzo. — Gabriele D'Annunzio ed i suoi seguaci hanno denunciato un appello che i socialisti di Fiume hanno lanciato ai lavoratori del mondo, appello che e' stato pubblicato dal giornale "Avanti", organo del partito socialista.

L'appello dice che gli operai di Fiume hanno raggiunto in sommi i loro obiettivi ed implorano i compagni attraverso il mondo di salvarli. "Fame, imprigionamento, tortura e quanto grava su di noi per opera degli Arditi—

dice l'appello—ed il pazzo despota ed i suoi seguaci non hanno pietà e nella loro folle furia hanno raggiunto incredibili altezze."

SOCIALISTS HIT D'ANNUNZIO

Implore Aid Against "Mad Despot and His Followers"

Rome, March 30.—(By A. P.)—Captain Gabriele d'Annunzio and his followers are denounced in an appeal by the Socialists of Fiume to "the workmen of the entire world," published in Vanti, the Socialist organ. The appeal says the workmen of Fiume "have reached the summit of the Calvary and implore their companions throughout the world to save them."
"Hunger, imprisonment and torture are visited upon us by the Arditi, who are about to destroy us," the appeal continues. "The mad despot and his followers have no pity and their mad fury has reached unbelievable heights."

OXFORD DROPS GREEK RULE

Students Jubilant as Compulsory Language Study is Abolished

Oxford, March 30.—(By A. P.)—Oxford University, by a vote in convention of 434 to 359, has abolished compulsory Greek. Only those taking "final honors" other than in natural science, mathematics or jurisprudence are still required to pass in that language.

To celebrate the occasion hundreds of undergraduates organized what is known here as a "rag." Attired in ancient Greek costumes and headed by a Hellenic high priest carrying an urn filled with red hot ashes, they paraded the town and recited Greek verse in the market place.

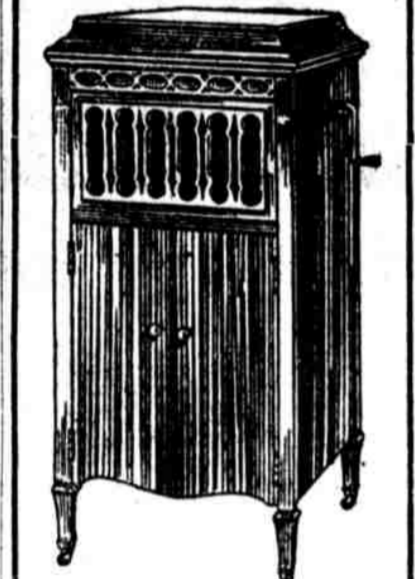

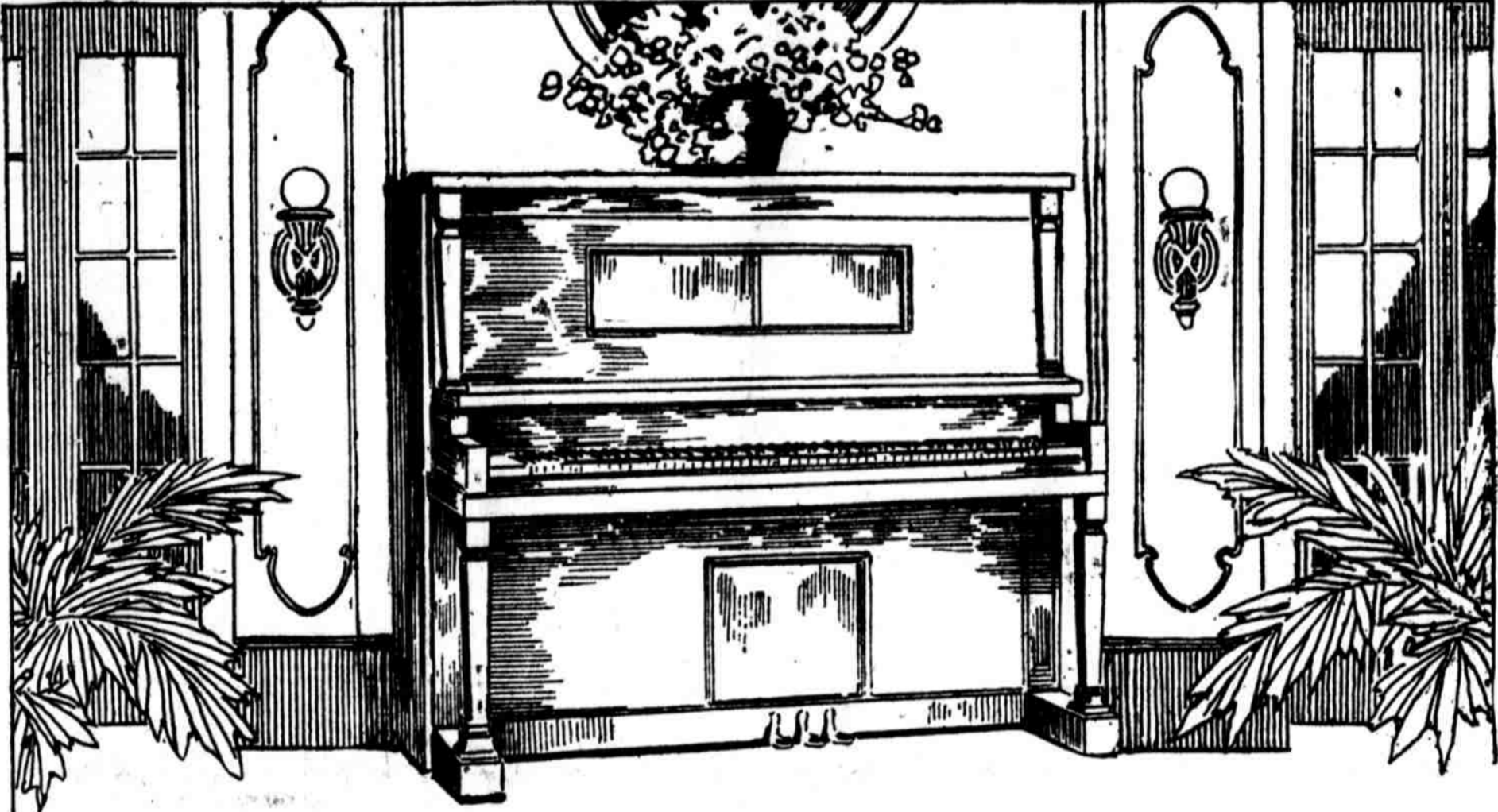

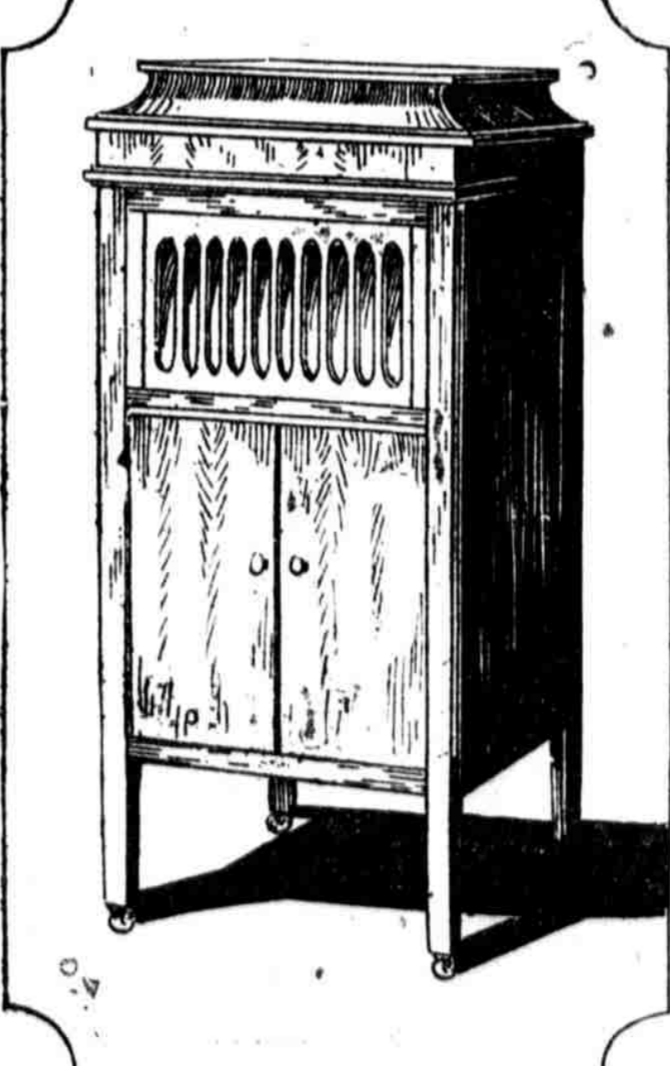
